Dear Sir,

Some months ago I requested
of my friends in Yamba, Africa, to send
me my library in that Country, so far as
practicable, and by some vessel communi-
cating with Baltimore. Since writing I have heard
nothing from it. It is probable your connection
with the Liberian Trade can enable you to give
me some information respecting the object of this
note. Can you inform me if any such vessel
has reached Baltimore in any of the Colo-
nization vessels? If it should come, I would
regard it a great favor, should you notify me
of the fact. I was for four years missionary
of the F. M. B. G. B. C. in Yamba, and compelled
to remain in the place on account of feeble health.
Any information you may possess on this
subject will very much oblige
