My dear Sir

I have received your note of the 28th inst. it asks if we will make a deduction of 25% on the price of the books provided the shipping charges be paid to be landed at Herts instead of going them to London or Calcutta. I do not think it worth while paying that sum. by 125% for the insurance. I understand Herts prices are much lower than either London or Calcutta, which would make it more desirable to have them at the lowest possible price. I would not be disposed to make more than 10% difference. by 35%
