 Society, five hundred dollars, amount to me in
 cash. I hereby request & order you to pay
 him the amount of the same, together with
 interest thereon, to be returned currently from date,
 of & from the first money coming into your hands
 or my attorney, from party or side of my need
 which now resides your charge, in the State of
 Illinois, deducting only from such receipts, amounts
 necessary for taxes & other legal charges & claims,
 if any, against the same - and that this order shall
 be your full & sufficient receipt for the same
 & bar against all other orders & claims from
 me till the full satisfaction thereof
 signed & sealed in the city of Baltimore this
 thirty first day of October 1859. Eighteen hundred
