Yours of yesterday received. I bought today 900 lb Rice for you @ 1/4 & sold in Bond & afterwards the seller found he had cut off a pair of duties on it all. There is not another lb to be bought this season may arrive - same daily expected. I have not wait for it - as go on with them. Every thing else of yours is bought except the big boxes of Rice. I bought yesterday 150 lb. Flour @ \$12.50 Cal. extra - houses & perfumery - all of better sort - & story of newspaper Wright - 1000 lb. new - his work at \$15 - shall get balance of "Wright" - Now I think all bought & will be a good Friday - a in good times.
