Sir;

Yours favour of the present year, without day or month,
I have received - It is, with regret, I inform you that I
have no knowledge of any coloured person in Talbot county, who
is willing at this time to emigrate to Africa, as in I know,
or any way, that there is any such person - It is to be lamented
that so few persons of the above description, are desirous of
relaying their own good; but so it is, & we must submit for
the present - I trust that the diffusion of proselytizing
travels may in some short time effect much - I am deeply
satisfied with the representation of the object, & well disposed
to promote it. I trust you will be pleased to find a list of the
officers of our society.
