he is still in the City awaiting the issue
of the present meeting of the Board.

The case of Mr. ^{Mr.} Gill is one which I think
of sufficient importance to require the appoint-
ment of a special Committee. Although
very recently supplied with fifty dollars
by the Treasurer he is now in want of at
least one hundred dollars to make him
easy. The correspondence in reference to the
change which was recently effected in
his removal from Windsor to Hanover &
from the charge of Dr. Phelps to Dartmouth
College is at hand and may be seen if the
Board wish it.

It will be seen by a letter from Mr
R. P. Fendall of the ~~Washington~~
American Colonization Society that they
wish to send out emigrants and goods by
our fall expedition. I wrote Mr Fendall
that the Board would meet in a few days
when I would give him full information
as to the result, I therefore beg that the
letter may be referred to the Executive
Committee with power to instruct me
what to say.
