Dear Sir!--

Mr. G. W. S. Hall, Secretary of the Maryland Colonization Society, has informed Mr. Fendall, our Treasurer, of his intention to turn over to the custody of the American Colonization Society, a fund of Six Thousand Dollars ( \$6000.), known as the " Hall School Fund, " the income of which is to be applied to " the support of Primary Schools in the County of Maryland in Liberia." This Society is willing to accept and execute the trust if this arrangement is thought to be best and is satisfactory to all the parties interested in the matter.

In any event this Society will be pleased to learn from you what application has been made of this fund hitherto and to have a full account of the work and condition of the schools receiving its benefit.

Every thing relating to the educational progress of Liberia is of great interest to this Society.
