My dear Mr. Hall:-

This morning I received your letter of yesterday, the minute book of the Maryland State Colonization Society in which is a receipt prepared by Mr. Semmes for my signature; also on a separate paper a copy of a resolution adopted at a meeting of the Board of Managers of the Maryland Society, held March 23, 1891, and copy of the order of Messrs.
