To the Board of Managers
of the Maryland M. Col. Society
Gentlemen

By the request of the President I have prepared and now submit the following report of the transactions of the Society during the past year.

The receipts, from various sources, into the Treasury amount to \$18,160.02/100. derived from the following sources: received of State ^{and} Col. Managers ~~\$10,275~~ \$10,027.55/100; Annual Subscriptions & donations \$998.40/100; Mrs. Tubman for the outfit transportation & subsistence of her ^{\$4,900} servants; for tax on slaves introduced into the state \$556.25/100; for freight & passage of Missionaries & Emigrants \$812.23/100. Of Robt. Estlin & Episc^o Mission \$865.56/100. This statement embraces the transactions of twelve months, from the 15th Decr. 1836 to this date; during which period the Board were under the necessity of borrowing of the Union Bank of Maryland on a note of 12 Mos, the sum of \$1000, which will be paid in a few days.
