

by a majority of the members elected to both Houses, according to the rules and limitations prescribed in case of a bill.

Sec. 16. There shall be elected, in each county by the qualified voters thereof, one Sheriff and one Coroner, at the times and places of holding Elections for members of the General Assembly. They shall continue in office for two years, and until successors shall be chosen and qualified.

Sec. 17. There shall be a Seal of this State which shall be kept by the Governor, and used by him officially; and shall be called, the Seal of the State of Maryland in Liberia.
