

In the last Will and Testament of John Dillehunt
deceased, which bears date the sixth day of April in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty
two, and which was proved on the thirtieth day of April
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
thirty two, among other expressions is the following. viz
"My will however is that my coloured boy Slave"
"James Ray now aged thirteen years and one "
"month be sold until he attain the age of twenty "
"eight years only; and after that period I declare "
"him discharged from Slavery & bondage"
