

An Extract from the last will and testament of Jane
Cooper Meaford late of Dorchester County deceased, dated
the 2^d day of July 1833 and proved 15th of the same month,
"Second, It is my will and desire that my man George
go free at my death"

I have here set my name and the public
Seal of my office affixed this 20th day of

Gen. Meason. We have not seen the executor named in the will
above referred to, there being as yet no administration on the dec^d
Estate. We have seen the negro personally and would say
not officially, he is about 30 years of age.
