three, the said Philip Hammond Hopkins doth release
from Slavery himself and set free negro women
Sally Williams and her three children James Johnson
two years of age, William Johnson five years of
age and Jacob Henry Williams four months old

recorded the 14th day of November 1833

Philip Hammond Hopkins resides about fifteen miles
from Annapolis, and the above negroes are to
remain from the State in the course of the morning week
with those manumitted by Thomas Buff
