

By an Indenture bearing date the seventh day of December
Anno Domini eighteen hundred and thirty three, Sally Sollett of
Somerset County Maryland, manumitted and set free, her negro man
named Charles, being of the age of thirty two years, to be free when
the said negro man named Charles shall attain to the age of forty
four years, or at the period of the death of said Sally Sollett.

Which said deed of manumission is duly executed and recorded
among the Records of Somerset County Court, on the 17th day of December
Anno Domini 1833.
