

Frederick Clerk's office March 27-1840

In compliance with an act of December session 1831 Chap 281. The clerk of Frederick County Court returns to the board of managers the following extract of two Bills of sale recorded in his office since last return.

Thomas J. Davis & B. A. Cunningham } Sale dated 24th and recorded 25th March 1840.

to Thomas Whitter } By which is sold to the said Thomas Whitter a negro man named Benjamin Cobington aged about 25 or 6 years and to serve the said Thomas Whitter until the 12th day of February 1846. at which time he will be entitled to his freedom no description given parties reside in Frederick county.

Jacob Thomas of Mo } Sale dated 26th and recorded 27th March 1840.

to Jonathan Herring } By which is sold to the said Jonathan Herring a negro man named Ann and her male infant. the said negro Ann to serve

the said Jonathan Herring for the term of 15 years commencing from the 26th March A.D. 1840 and ending on the 26th March A.D. 1855. the said male child is to continue the property of said Jonathan Herring until he shall have reached his 35th year. the said infant or child having been born on the 11th day of March last. no description given grantor resides in Frederick county. grantor in Chariton County Missouri
