Ephraim. the said woman Kitty is of black
Complexion, and small in stature, and was
born on the 10th day of March in the year 1827
and to serve the said Regim Simpson, his heirs
and assigns. until she shall arrive at the
age of 25 years. which will take place, on the
10th day of March 1852. and her child Ephraim
shall serve until he shall arrive to the age
of 25 yrs. the said child Thomas Ephraim was born
on the 14th day of January in the year 1842
and will be 25 yrs of age on the 14th day of January
in the year 1867. The future issue if any of the said
Kitty shall be free. at the age of 25 years.
