 Negro Kitty & her child is released from slavery

 the said negro woman Kitty of black complexion
 and small stature, and also her child Thomas
 Ephraim. The said Kitty was born on the 10th day
 of March in the year 1827. and her child was born
 on the 14th day of January in the year 1842. the said
 woman Kitty shall serve until she arrives to
 the age of 25 yrs. which will take place, on the
 10th March in the year 1852. and her son Thomas
 Ephraim shall serve until he shall arrive to the
 age of 25 years. which will be, on the fourteenth
 day of January in the year 1867. and the future
 issue if any, of the said Kitty shall all serve
 until they arrive to the age of 25 yrs. The said
 Kitty and her child Thomas Ephraim being
 both sane, and sound, and she able to work &
 gain a sufficient livelihood & maintained
 Parties live in Fred. County Md
