

In the last Will and Testament of Jane Cahill deceased, bearing date the fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three, and proved and recorded in the Office of the Register of Wills for Baltimore County on the first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five are the following clauses, viz:

" 1st I do hereby manumit, liberate and set free (her freedom to take
" effect from and immediately after my decease) my negro woman "
" Charlotte Saunders, now aged about Thirty years. "
" 2^d I give and devise unto John Young Esquire of the City of Balti-
" more, his Executors and Administrators, whatever money I may have
" at the time of my death, in the Savings Bank of Baltimore, in trust,
" that after paying all my just debts and funeral expenses, if any "
" should remain, he hold the same to the proper use and benefit of "
" the aforesaid Charlotte Saunders, to be paid to her at such times "
" and in such sums, as he in his discretion may think best, without "
" being subject to the power or control of, or liable for the debts or "
" engagements of any husband the said Charlotte may have: But "
" if the said Charlotte should depart this life without having received "
" the whole of said sum of money; then I give and devise the same "
" immediately after the death of said Charlotte to my sister Ann Hender-
" -son, if she should then be alive, to be forthwith paid over to her; "
" or her order; and in case the said Ann Henderson should have "
" departed this life before the death of said Charlotte, then I give "
" and devise any remaining funds as aforesaid, unto the said "
" John Young his executors and administrators absolutely. "
