

To the President of the Board of Managers for Maryland for
removing the People of color of said State

Sir

Enclosed herewith an Extract taken from
the last will and testament of John Williams late of Worcester
County deceased & executed on the 24th day of November 1839
and proved and filed in the office of the Register of Wills March
21st 1839

Item Ninth I give to my negro woman
Eloise and Sarah their freedom in three years after my
death I give to my boy Bill now six years his freedom
when he shall arrive at the age of eight years and
Margaret now six years old Sally now five years old
and Alice now one year old each their freedom when
they shall respectively arrive at the age of twenty
five years

I hereby certify that the foregoing is a
true Extract taken from the last will
and testament of John Williams deceased
In testimony whereof I hereto subscribe
my name and affix the Seal of my
Office this Twenty Second day of March
Anno Domini 1839
