A. C. Shipley } term of 11 years 8 mo & 23 days from the date hereof,

John W. Wood } Sale dated the 2<sup>d</sup> & recorded the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April  
to } by which is sold to said Election, a negro slave  
Green S. Election } named Emily for the term of 19 years from 19<sup>th</sup> January 1858.

Lewis C. Kemp } Sale dated 18<sup>th</sup> & Recorded 22<sup>d</sup> April 1858, by which is  
Ezra of Lewis & } sold to said Bushey, a negro man named Joshua Bowings  
Rebecca Kemp } to serve until 1<sup>st</sup> April 1868, Nancy Bowings his wife to  
to } serve until 1<sup>st</sup> April 1871 and their children - John to serve  
Jacob Ill. Bushey } until 1<sup>st</sup> July 1892, Charles to serve as a slave till 1<sup>st</sup>  
August 1895, all of which slaves, at the end of their  
respective terms shall be free from all manner  
of service to him, or any other person or persons.

Eli Ott } Sale date 21<sup>st</sup> & Recorded 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1858  
or } by which is sold a negro girl named Charlotte  
John A. Martin } Waters for the term of 5 years from the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of  
Sept<sup>r</sup> 1858, and then to be free.

Isaac A. Wood } Sale dated & Recorded 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, by which  
or } is sold to said Blaggett a negro man named Gato  
Thomas Blaggett } Graham to serve until the 25<sup>th</sup> Feb<sup>r</sup> 1876 & then to be free.

Charles L. Kemp } Sale dated & Recorded May 17<sup>th</sup> 1858, by which is sold  
to } to said Mingle a negro man named Julius Beaser to serve  
L. J. Mingle } until 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1876, & Adelaide Maffie to serve until  
1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1877, and both then to be free.
