Emory of Talbot County, in the State of Maryland, do hereby manumit and set free my negro slave, Alfred Baily of light complexion and aged about twenty three years, from and after the first day of January in the year 1873, when the said negro Alfred Baily will be about thirty five years of age, reserving the services of the said negro slave in the meantime to me, my heirs and assigns -
