While it is the wish of the Board of Managers that there should be a full allowance given to them, it is their duty to provide against and prevent extravagance. You will keep an account of the quantity of stores consumed, and hand it to Governor Pusey on your arrival at Cape Palmas. You will also return a copy of it, with a report of the voyage, by the first opportunity, to the Board of Managers
