

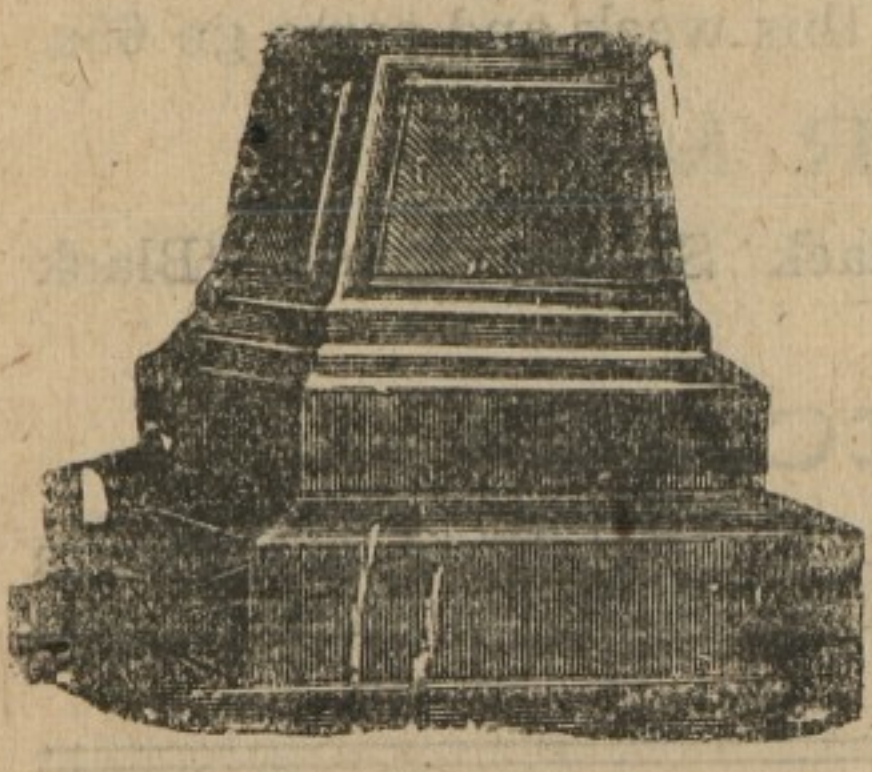

GIRLS' CLUBS HOLD CAMP

The Girls' Clubs of Kent county will hold their second annual camp at Washington College on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, July 25th to 27th inclusive.

The camp is held in co-operation with the Maryland University and the United States Department of Agriculture.

At the present time there are ten clubs in the county with a membership of 155 girls. Meetings are held twice a month at each of these clubs, and are conducted many times independently of the adult leader.

Since the close of school Club meetings have been held weekly. This will then make it possible for the Home Demonstration Agent to visit the girls in the homes during the month of August and give individual instruction in the sewing and poultry work.

In addition to the required work, some clubs have held exhibits, some have held open club meetings, planning their own programs and conducting their own business meetings. They have raised funds to pay for sewing two prize-winning girls to Club Week at the University of Maryland which includes a trip to Washington and Mount Vernon.

The girls who came long distances on the hottest summer days to attend a club meeting have done a large part in making the summer a success.

The Four-H Camps which are now held in many other states are planned in order that Club Boys and Girls may have the proper incentive which is necessary in all Junior Extension Work and also that in mingling with others they may be inspired to lift themselves to higher standards in their work. With every girls heart in the work, head cleared for action, hands ready and willing and health prepared to benefit by the change and rest, we will have everything in shape to make this camp the best one we have ever had.

Wednesday July 27th will be known as boys' and girls' club day. The families of all boys and girls who are club members are invited to spend this day at the College. Pack a picnic lunch and let's get together for the sake of the boys and girls. A program is being especially prepared which will begin at 9.30 a. m. There will be good speakers, music, games and plenty to eat.

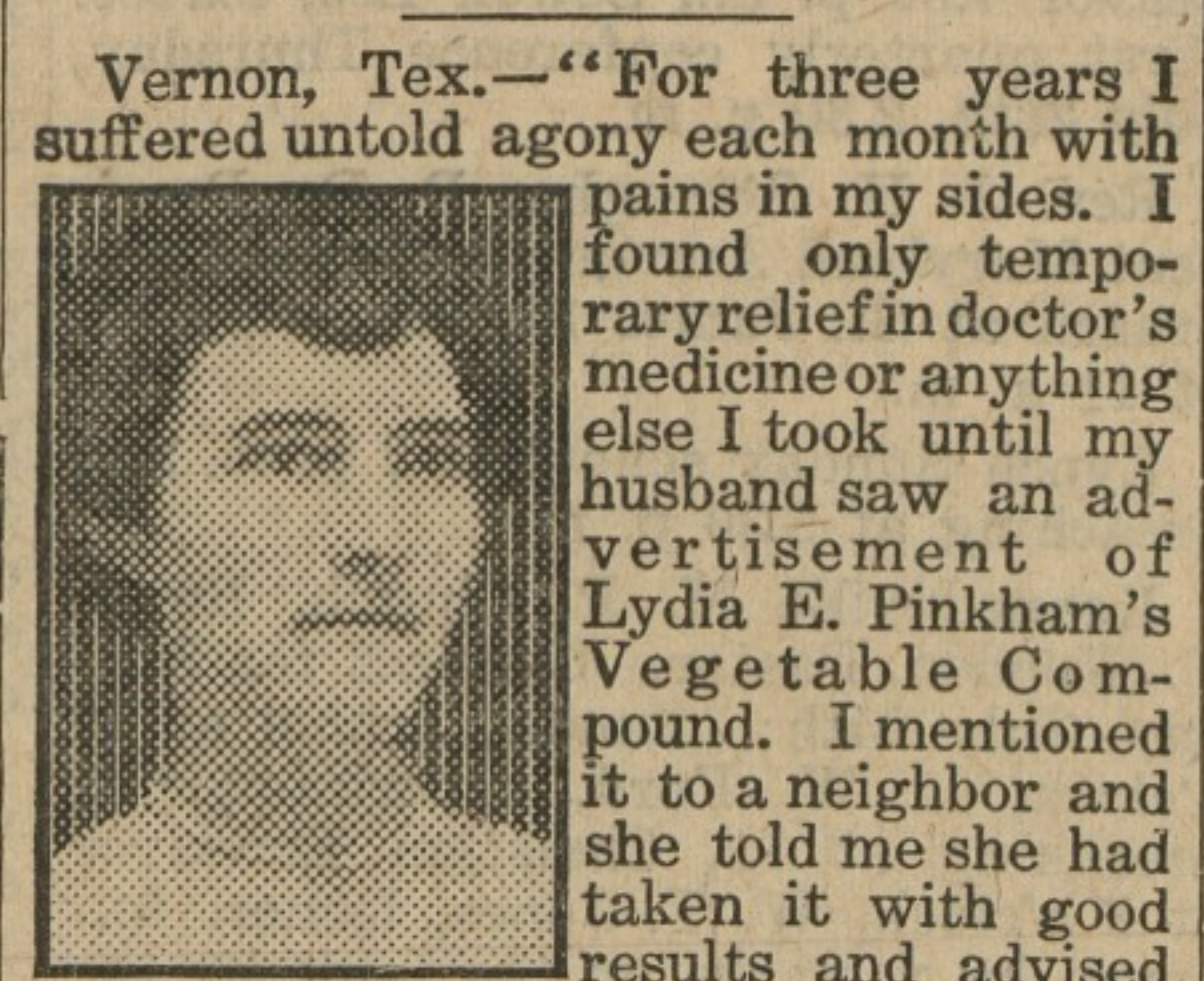

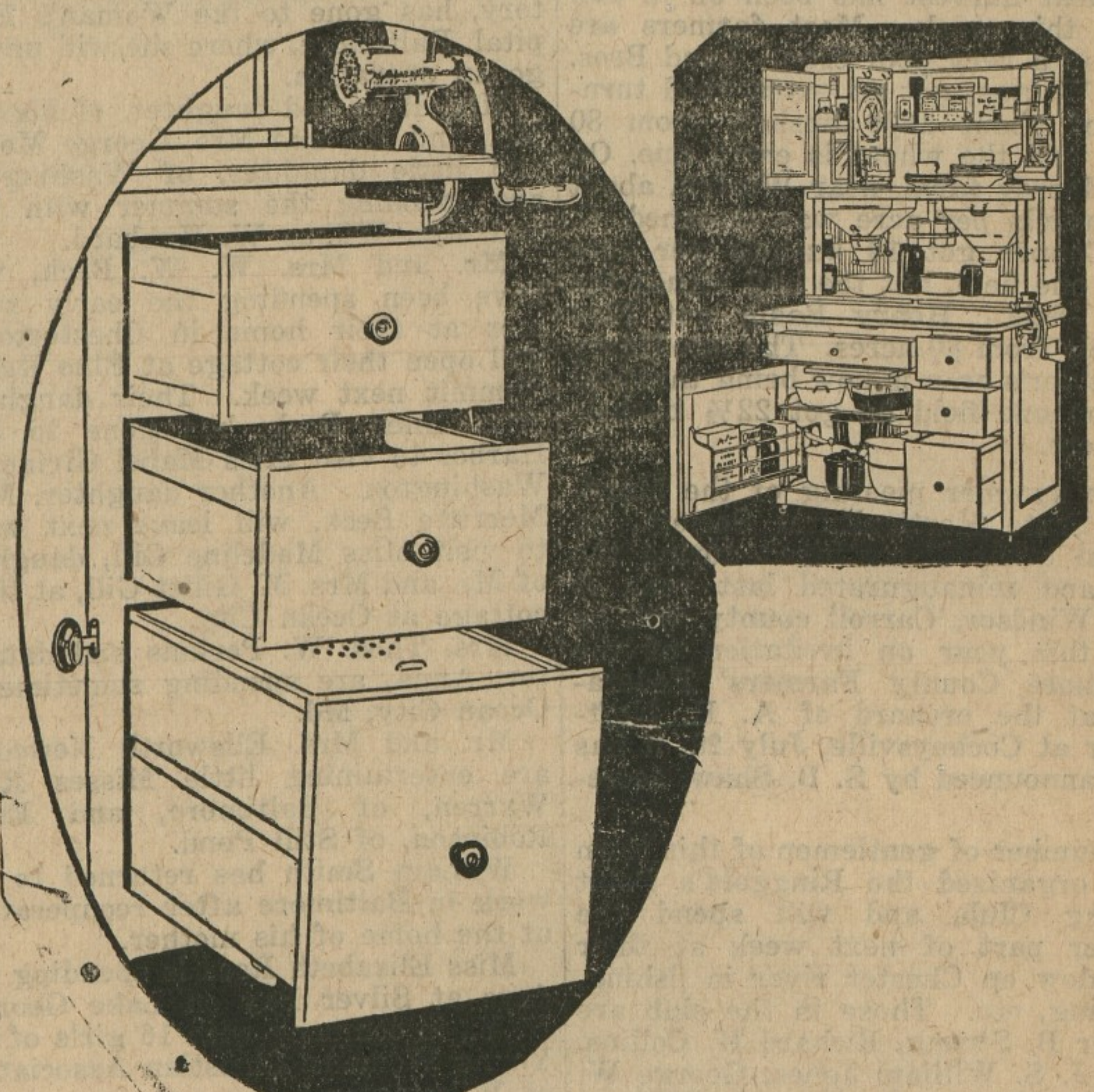
