KENT BOYS PLAY WELL

The following letter from J. W. Hrons, of Beacom College, Wilmington, will be interesting to our readers:

"Gentlemen—I was very glad to see that in your last issue you gave credit to a Kent boy, Owen Selby, of Rock Hall, for pitching a fine game when Beacom College played DuPont High. Being a former Kent County boy myself, I know how encouraging it is to a boy away from home to have the home papers take note of his achievements elsewhere. Believing that you take pleasure in this sort of thing, I am writing to call your attention to the fact that three other Kent county boys are making a splendid showing on our baseball team. When Beacom College team defeated Newark High by a score of 18 to 8 Selby and Rogers did the pitching. Rogers is a Kent county boy and lives on a farm near Black Station. In a hard-fought game, Beacom College team defeated the crack Salesianum High of Wilmington. This team had played eight or ten games before we crossed bats with them and had only been defeated once when they came up against Beacom's. By the end of the day, they were charged with two defeats, and the Beacom victory was due in no small measure to the playing of "Dick" Woodall, who pitched a wonderful game, allowing only five hits; although the Beacom team got ten hits off the Salesianum pitcher, "Andy" Woodall, the other Kent county boy, is the Beacom star center fielder. It was "Andy" who made the run in the Salesianum game that changed the score from a tie to a victory for Beacom in the last half of the 9th. "Andy" and "Dick" are brothers and their home is at Galena. You may think that these boys are merely good ball players. Every boy in the school knew before the team was organized that if he neglected his studies he would not make the team; and, if a boy neglects his studies, now he will be dropped from the team. Our position in regard to athletics is that a sound body makes for a healthier and more active brain, and that the proper mixture of athletics with educational work is a mighty good thing for the young people.

The Beacom baseball team with five reserves starts out on Monday, May 15, for a two weeks' trip extending through Delaware, Maryland and Virginia, ending with a game with Chestertown High at Chestertown on Saturday morning, May 27. Since four members of the Beacom baseball aggregation are Kent county boys, this should be a very interesting game to the people of Kent."

"Jeff," the postoffice alligator which had been a great pet in the office since early in December last, died Saturday evening. The alligator had not eaten anything since its arrival from the South and is the second of the three that sent to friends here to succumb to the cold climate.

The Sunday school of Emmanuel P. E. Church, Chestertown, was awarded prizes at Easton Saturday for having raised the largest amount of money per capita, \$300, during the past year for missions, and also the largest amount of any of the Sunday schools in the diocese.

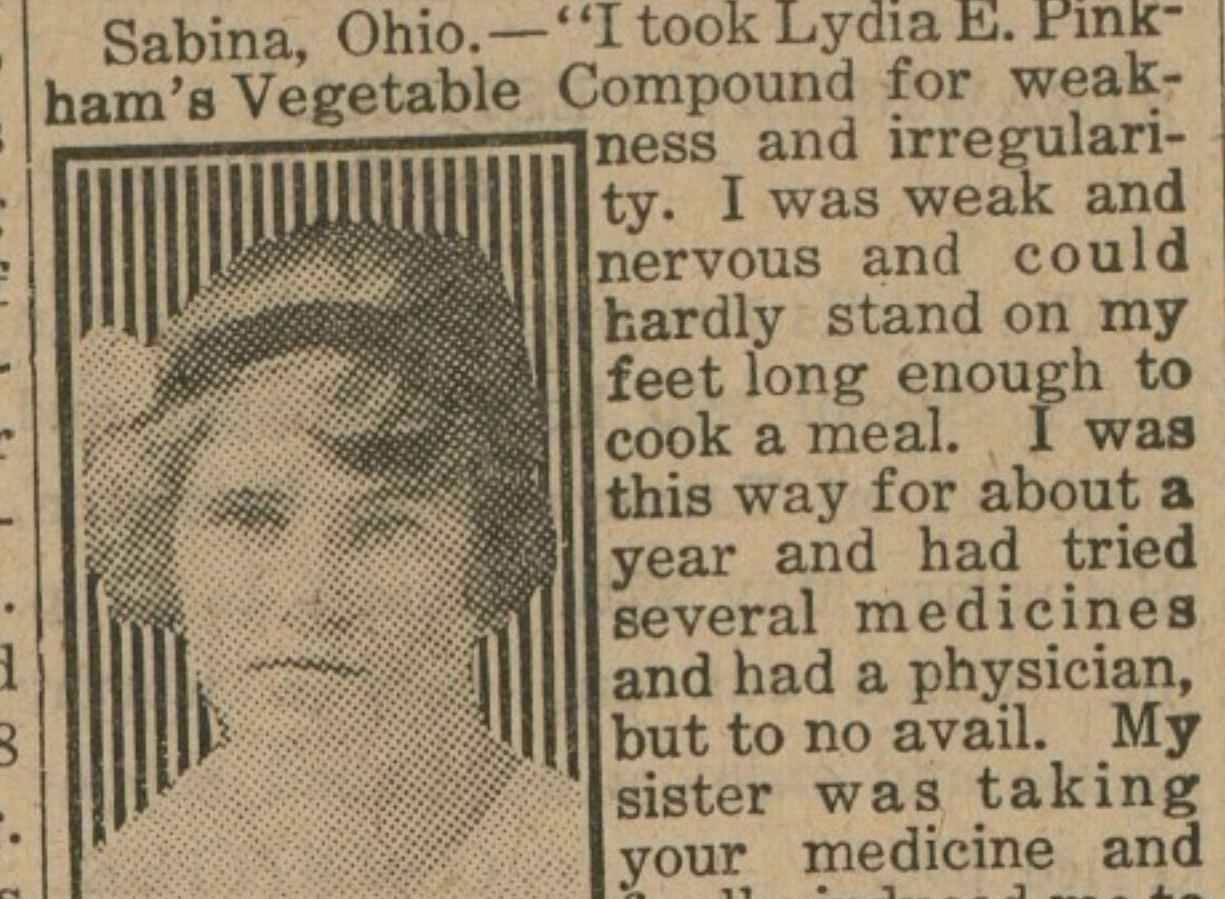
