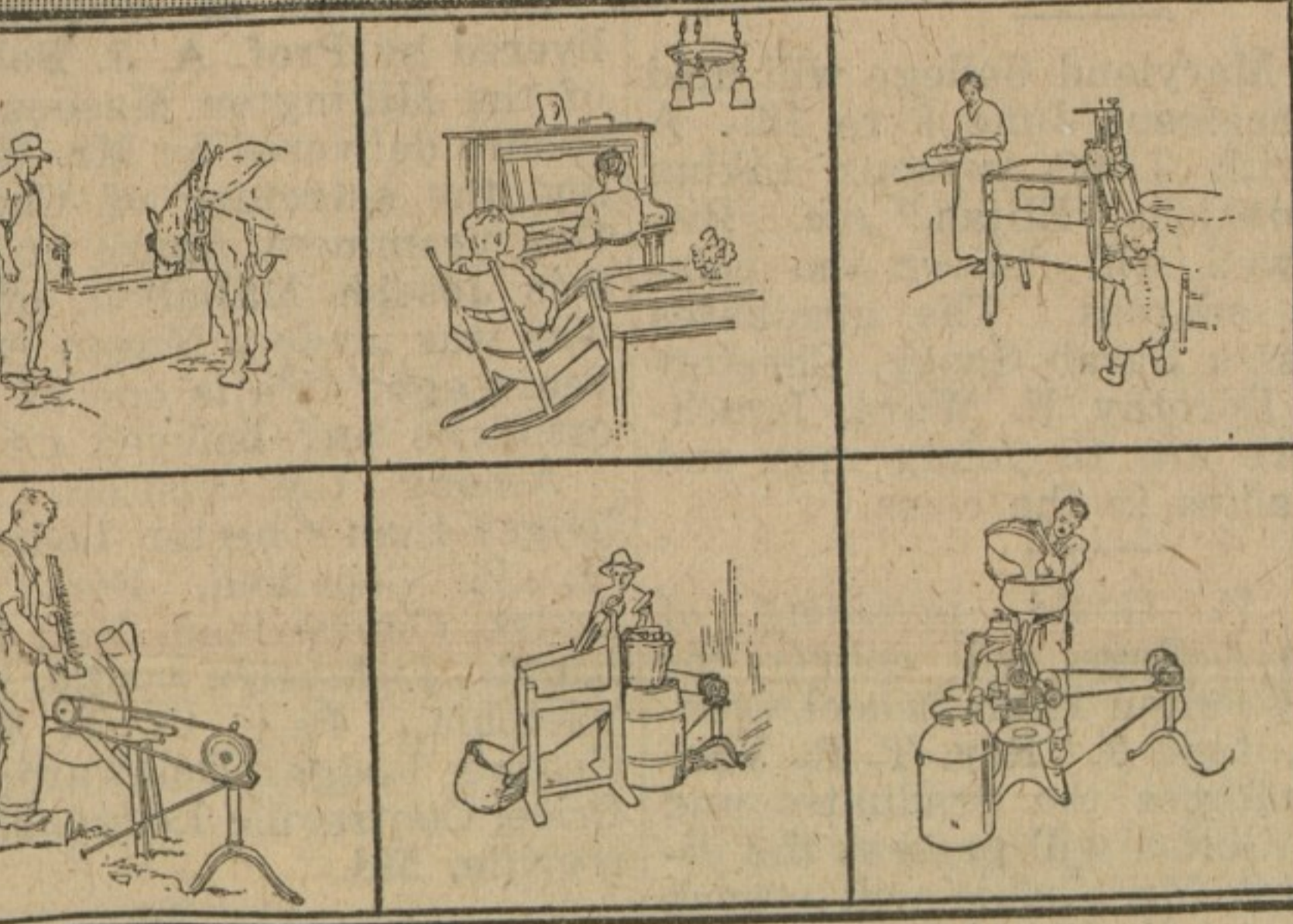

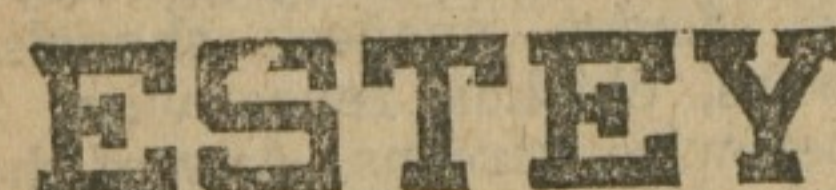

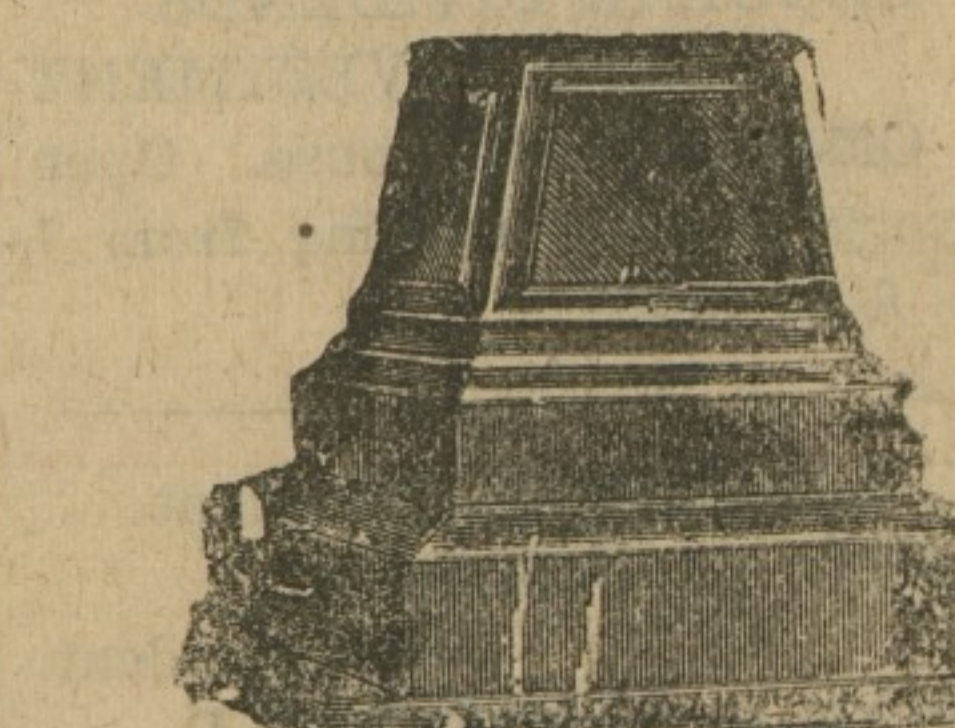

High Schools Will Compete In Events At Washington College Saturday—Big Day Tuesday.

Chestertown within the next few days will be the scene of two very important track and field meets. Saturday Washington College will hold its initial Eastern Shore Championship meet, and Tuesday, May 30, the American Legion, Post 36, will hold its second annual meet, open to all contestants.

The Eastern Shore championship athletic meet, conducted by the Washington College authorities, is a novel institution and is attracting attention many distant high schools having entered. The high schools from the Eastern Shore of Virginia have also applied to enter, and the authorities intended to do so. The meet is in no way intended to detract from the attractiveness of the annual championship meet held at Homewood by the Public Athletic League, but, on the contrary, it is intended to get the Shore athletics interested in track work so as to make a creditable showing when they appear in Baltimore.

The entry list for the Eastern Shore meet is open not only to winners at the county meets but also to all bona fide students who can meet the age and weight conditions, which are the same as required by the Public Athletic League.

Suitable medals will be awarded the winners in each event—gold for first place, silver for second and bronze for third. High point scorers and record breakers also will be rewarded. Lunch will be served the contestants, and for those from the three lower counties sleeping accommodations will be provided over Friday and Saturday nights.

Immediately after the track meet is over there will be a baseball game between Gettysburg College and Washington College. At 8:30 p. m. of the same day the Washington College Glee Club will give a minstrel show.

PASTOR DRIVES CAR AGAINST BEE SWARM
