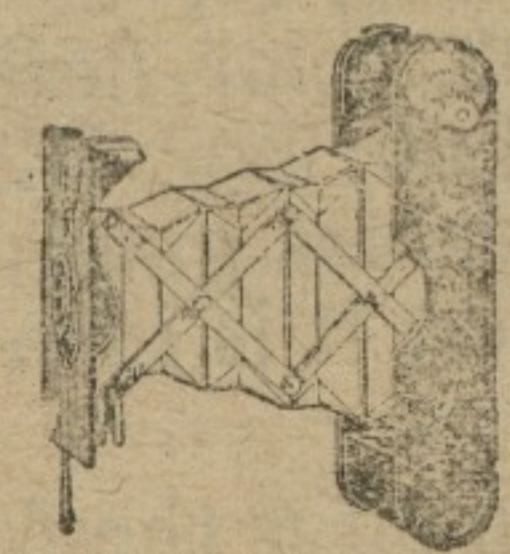

"MT. SPECULATION IS FINALLY TO BE SOLD

"Mt. Speculation," the ancient manor on the east side of the stone road leading from Elkton down the Eastern Shore, in Cecil County, and running along the Sassafras river for more than a mile, is to be sold on August 29th next by Joshua Clayton, Trustee, appointed under an order of the Circuit Court for Cecil County, in Equity.

This property has long been in the Eldridge family and was first acquired by Griffith Morgan Eldridge from Thomas W. Veasey in 1839 and for a number of years was passed from one member of the Eldridge family to the other with the request that the grantee or devisee would provide against sale of the property to a stranger. The family finally vested it in F. Howard Eldridge, a noted Philadelphia lawyer, who devised it to a son of his brother, Edwin James Eldridge, who lived in America, Sumter County, Georgia. This member of the family was Griffith Morgan Eldridge and the provisions of E. Howard Eldridge's Will were that his nephew should hold and enjoy the property during his life and at his death it was to go to his son, Griffith Morgan Eldridge, and at the death of the latter it was to go to his oldest male child then living. At the time of the making of the Will of F. Howard Eldridge, his grandnephew, Griffith Morgan Eldridge, had no children living but within the time against which the "rule of perpetuities" provides, a son was born, who's name is Griffith Morgan Eldridge and who is nine (9) years of age and now lives in Georgia. The father of the infant committed suicide on March 23rd last and his widow, Mrs. Mamie M. Eldridge, instituted suit for the sale of the property in Cecil County as the entail had been broken and the fee simple had been vested in her son.

The property consists of about six hundred acres of land, of which four hundred and sixty are either tillable or are in spacious lawns covered with age-old trees. The balance of the land is either in virgin oak or other forest trees, while locust trees in great numbers are scattered all over the property, enough, it is said, to furnish fencing material for the lower half of Cecil County. Judge Wickes who signed the decree for sale, fixed the bond of the Trustee at \$50,000.00, if a personal bond, and the sale of the property is being advertised in Cecil, Kent and Queen Anne's Counties, Maryland, and in New Castle County, Delaware, and is expected to draw a large number of buyers of real estate for investment or residential purposes. The "Eldridge Farm" is one of the most noted farms in Cecil County and the fact that it has been entailed property for three-quarters of a century adds interest because the entail is broken and the Circuit Court is vested with the authority to decree a sale.

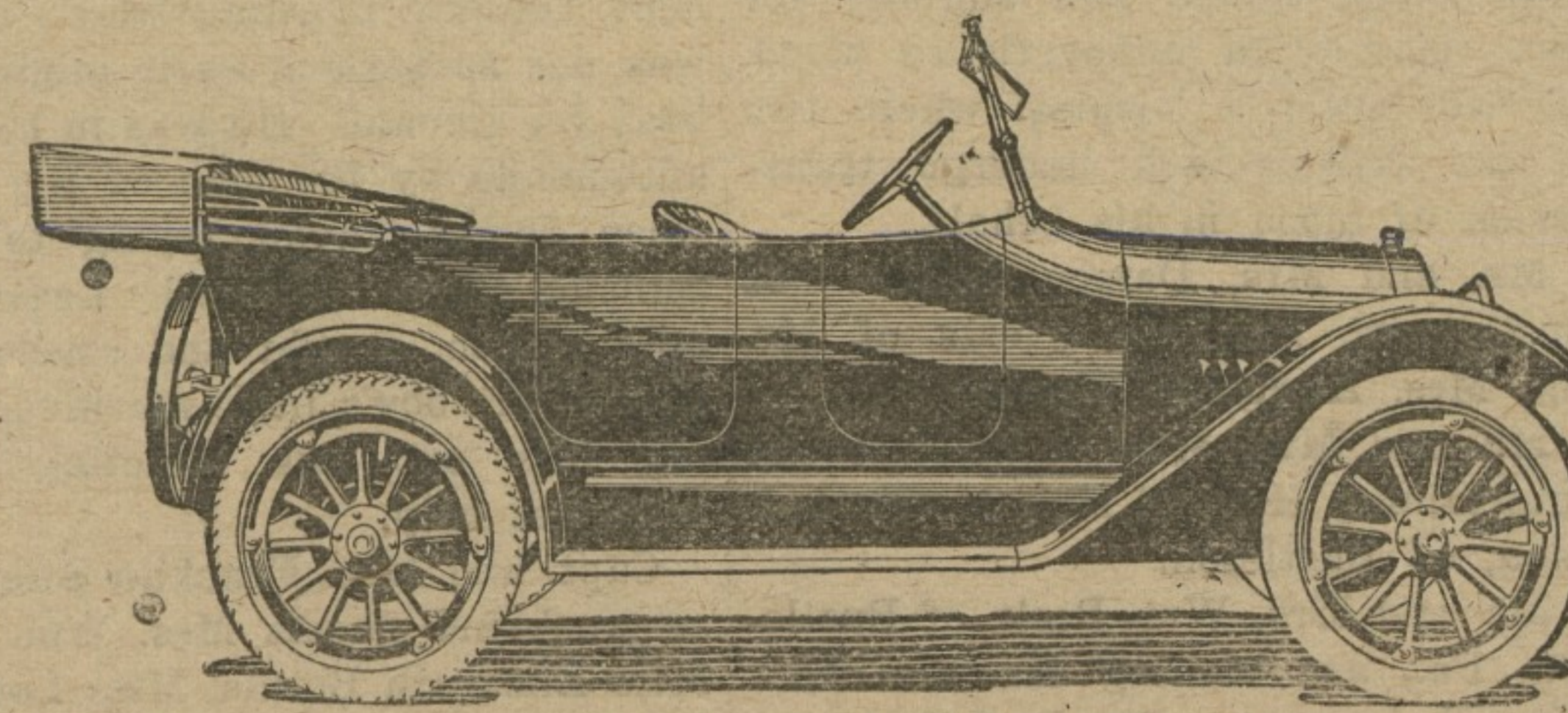
