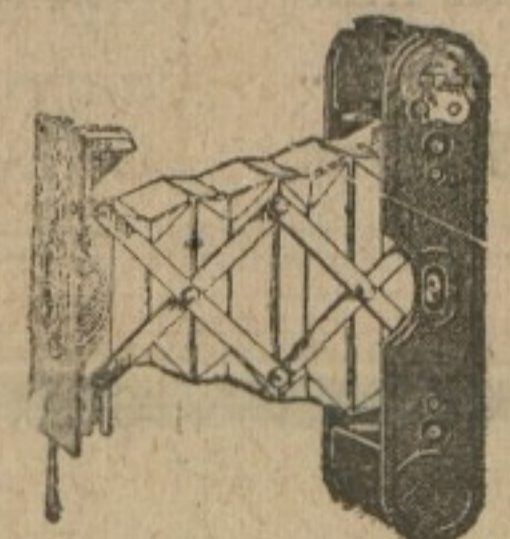

EASTON WITHOUT FUEL

Owing to the coal strike the Easton Light and Fuel Company, which furnishes gas here, shut down for want of coal or coke. Many families had to go hungry all day. Those having wood, coal oil or gasoline stoves in many cases allowed their neighbors to bring their food and cook it.

People were running about to secure coal oil and gasoline stoves upon which to cook their meals. One dealer said he had secured through the public service commission several tons of coke from Baltimore on Friday, which was shipped to Clayborne by way of the Baltimore, Chesapeake and Atlantic Railway.

The railroad, however, failed to haul to Easton Saturday and the dealer went to Claybourne with a truck to bring a load of coke to Easton in an effort to make gas.

Diocesan Funds Show Big Increase

Compilation of figures taken from the reports of the parishes in the Diocese of Easton, just completed by the secretary of the diocese, show the wonderful strides made by the diocese under Bishop Davenport in the matter of finances. For the first full calendar year, that of 1921, the total contributions from all sources amount to over \$120,000, and this is over \$7,000 more than for the last diocesan year reported.

Congressman Goldsborough Speaks Before Men's Community Club

A goodly representation greeted Congressman T. Alan Goldsborough on Monday night in response to an announcement that he would be the speaker of the evening. After a short routine of the general business, the speaker was introduced. Mr. Goldsborough held his audience for an hour in which he discoursed upon the general unrest of the times, business depression, uncertainty and kindred attendants following unstable conditions. His note was for stabilization. He did not profess to know, but gave his audience the benefit of his deep study upon economics, the monetary upheavals, and the explosions between corporations and labor. Mr. Goldsborough is not afraid to tackle the questions which are most vital to the welfare of America, and he deals with them from his angle fairly and conscientiously. He has made some telling speeches upon the floor of the House in spirited debates, and edited the club with casual review of problems that Congress had to meet. The lecture did not savor of politics, nor was it staged to strengthen his chances for renomination. He poses more as a student who, being in position to help his constituency, desires to give them the best as he understands it. His speech was well received, applauded, and rising vote of thanks tendered.—From Easton Star-Democrat.

The procession, which moved with the utmost precision and, so far as the pedestrians were concerned, in absolute silence, was viewed by many interested spectators. 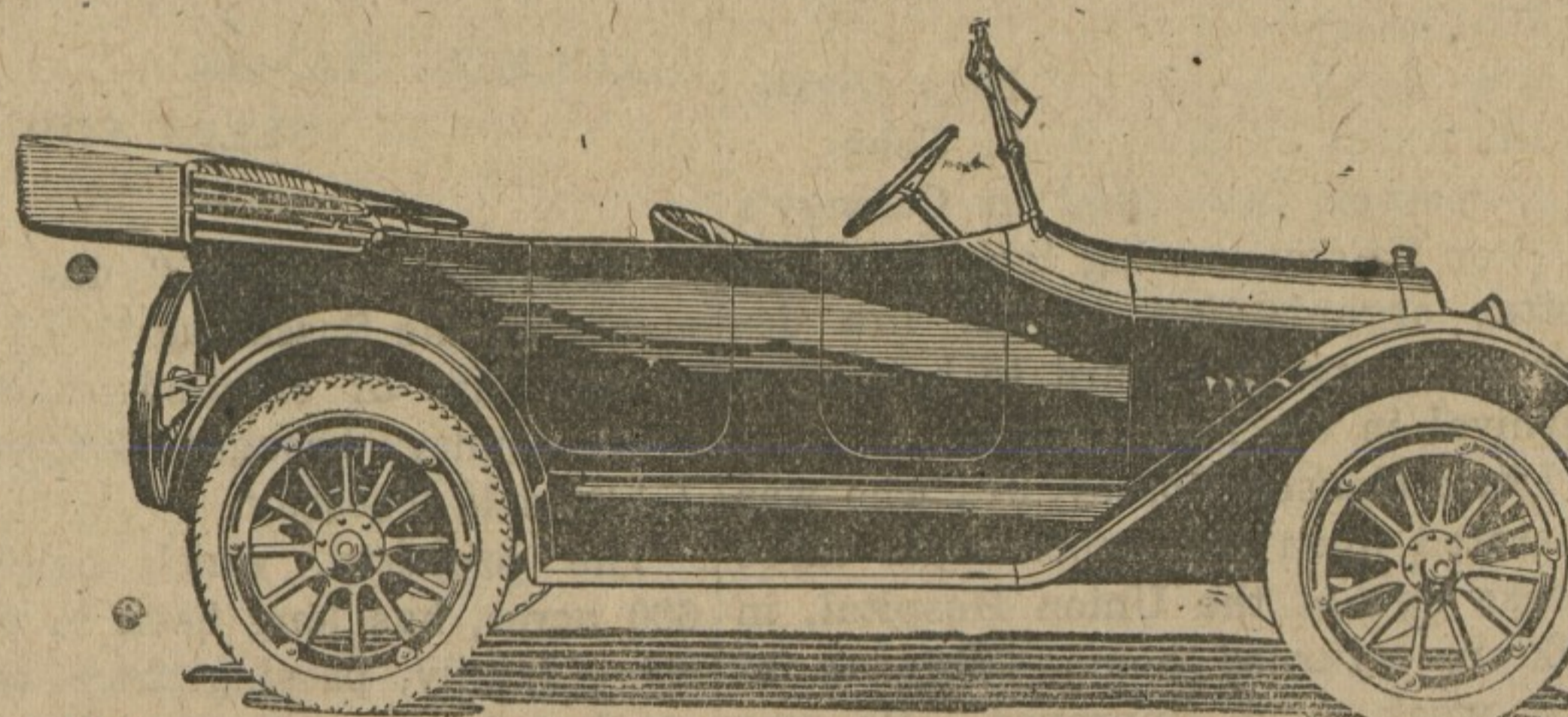

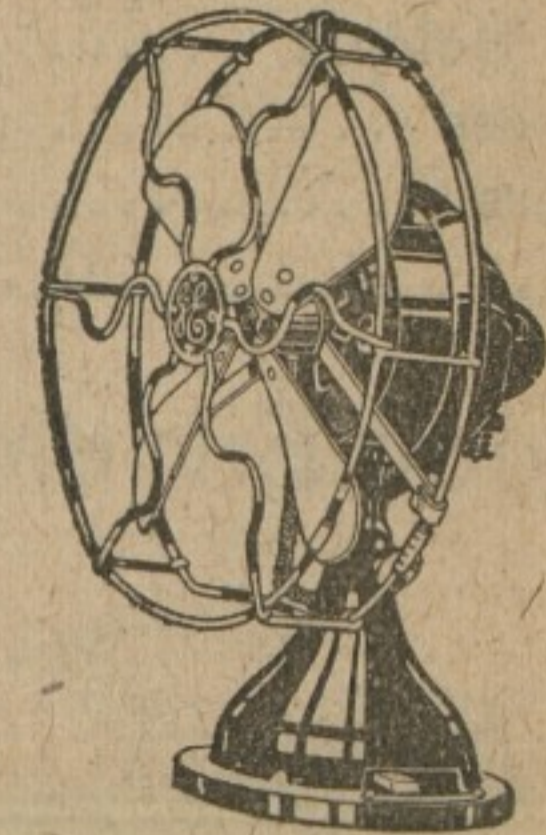
