**SCHOOL DEPARTMENT**

**TEACHERS' MEETING**

The March meeting of the Teachers' Association of Kent County, Md., was held on Friday afternoon of last week. With the exception of three teachers who were sick, there was a perfect attendance.

A demonstration lesson in the teaching of algebra was given before the high school group by Miss Mary G. Simpers, of the Rock Hall High School faculty.

After the lesson, Mr. E. Clarke Fountain, District High School Supervisor for the counties on the Eastern Shore, Harford and Anne Arundel, conducted a critique and lead the high school teachers in a discussion of the principles underlying the teaching of mathematics.

Children in the second grade of the Chestertown School, directed by their teacher, Mrs. Ida S. Parks, sang a number of songs before the group of elementary school teachers. Their singing was an excellent demonstration of what can be done in the development of fine tone quality, clear enunciation and a real appreciation of good music through the teaching of vocal music in the public schools.

The principal subject discussed by the teachers of this section was the retardation of school children in their progress through the grades. The causes of many children needing more than seven years to complete successfully the work of the seven grades of the elementary school were enumerated and ways by which the teacher can better aid the child to make normal progress were discussed.

The last twenty minutes were given over to Mr. Owen C. Blades, President of the Association for a joint meeting of the high school and elementary school groups.

The following officers were elected for the ensuing year: President, Owen C. Blades; Vice President, Harry R. Rasin; Secretary, W. A. P. Strang; Treasurer, Florence M. Jewell.

After the election of officers, the president distributed among the teachers, copies of the "Code of Professional Ethics for Teachers," on his recommendation, was unanimously adopted by the association. It is a transcript of the code of ethics for teachers adopted by the National Education Association of the United States at their meeting in Washington, D. C., in July, 1924. An association with such aims as those embodied in the code can not do otherwise than produce the highest type of teachers and always work consistently for the best educational opportunities for all of the boys and girls regardless of the difficulties to be overcome.

**WASHINGTON PLANS ECONOMICS DEGREE**

Need of Such Training Felt Some Time—Former Yale Man To Assist

The Washington College faculty has recently decided that the degree of bachelor of science in economics be offered students specializing in economics and business administration. The college already offers courses leading to the bachelor of arts and the bachelor of science degrees.

The new group of studies leading to the degree in economics is planned for the accommodation of those students contemplating a business career of any nature and is similar to the same courses given by the Wharton School of Finance of the University of Pennsylvania.

The new degree will be conferred during the next academic year and the work will be directed by Prof. George G. Snyder, formerly of the Wharton School.

The field covered by these new courses will embrace the economic resources of the United States, principles of accounting, business law, marketing problems, advertising, money and banking, railway transportation, taxation and public finance, international trade and tariff problems and the theory of economics.

For some time the need has been felt of providing those students who come particularly from the Eastern Shore with a training that will fit the growing business and agricultural problems of this section.

To that end these courses have been grouped for the selection of all those who are thinking of entering these fields of endeavor.

William R. Howell, professor of economics and formerly of Yale, will collaborate in conducting this work.
