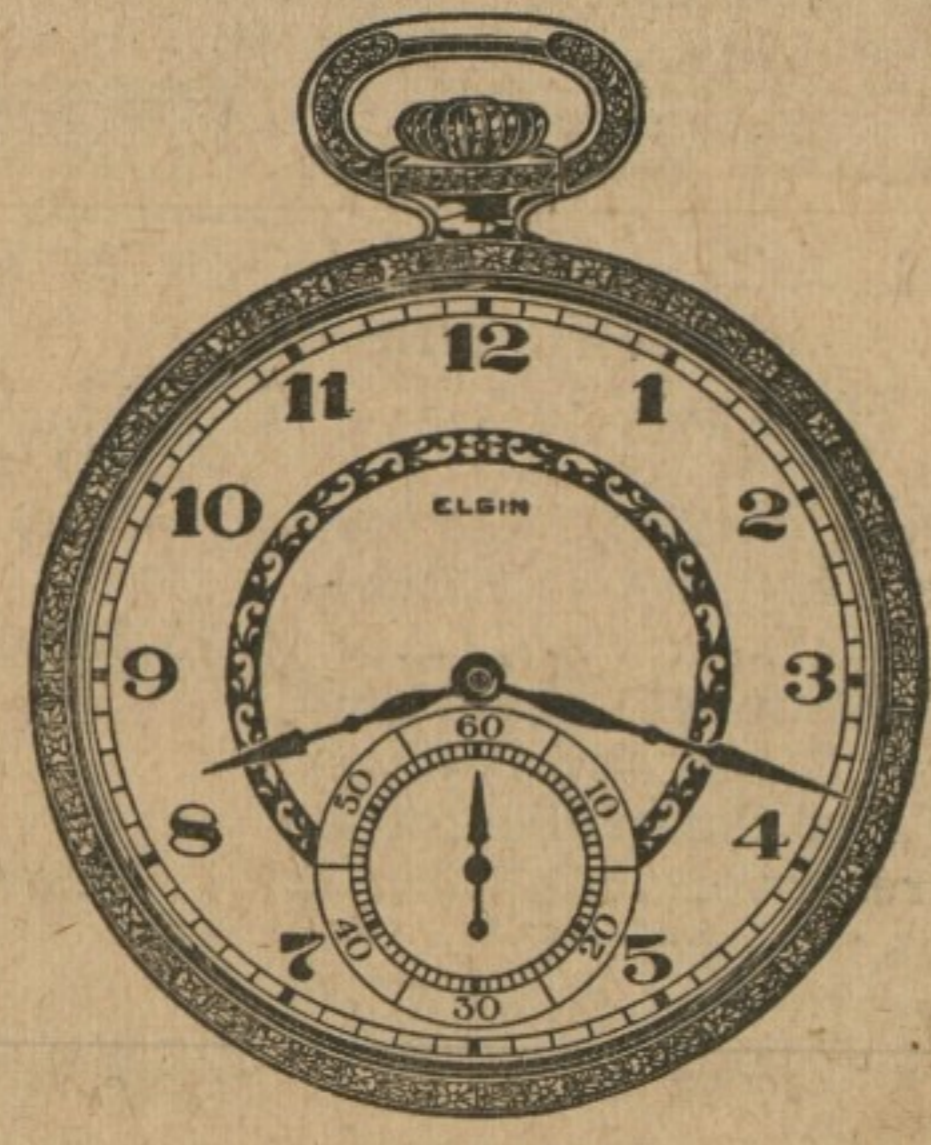

There was probated in the Orphans' Court for Kent County Tuesday the last will of the late Mrs. Mary A. Wilkins, of near Chestertown. It was made August 24, 1922. J. Henry Baker, Esq., of Baltimore, is the attorney for the executor, Edw. M. Wilkins. The witnesses were J. Henry Baker, Esq., and Parlett Brenton. The will provides as follows: I give and devise all my estate, real and personal, as follows, it being my desire that each of my five children, Sue W. Hines, wife of William D. Hines, of Baltimore City; Fannie W. Perkins, wife of Thomas B. Perkins, of Germantown, Philadelphia, Jennie Wilkins, Grace Wilkins and Edward M. Wilkins, of Kent County, Maryland, shall receive an equal, real part of my property and estate, real and personal, each sharing equally, and to that end, I hereby direct that the appraised value of all my personal property shall be taken at its real value to be determined by the inventory filed in my estate, and that the value of my home farm, called "The Maples," upon which I now

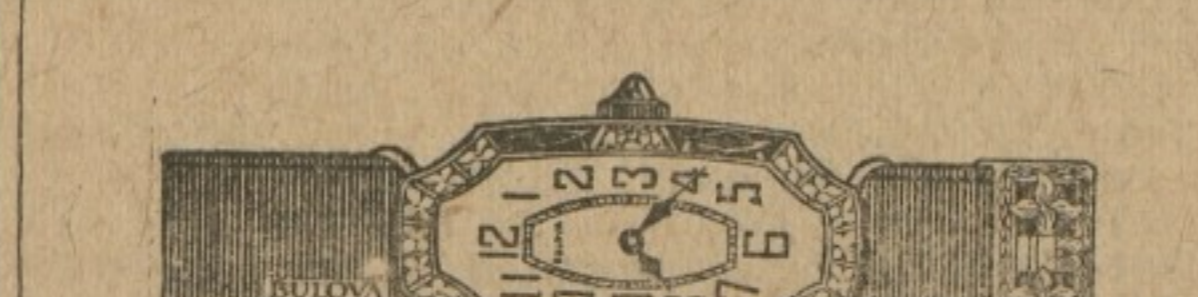

reside and situate in Quaker Neck, Kent County, Maryland, shall be ascertained and determined by three appraisers namely, Edward W. Emory, Elwin Leonard Maslin and William J. Maslin, all of Kent county, should my said children be unable to agree among themselves as to the valuation of the said farm, and the value placed upon said farm by any two of said appraisers shall be taken as the real value of said farm for the division herein made; and upon the basis of the valuation of my real and personal property so ascertained and determined, I give and devise to my children, Jennie Wilkins, Grace Wilkins and Edward M. Wilkins, their heirs and assigns, as tenants in common, share and share alike, my said home farm called "The Maples," upon which I now reside, with all the household furniture, silverware, ornaments, rugs and cooking utensils, contained in the dwelling thereon at the time of my death.

All the rest, residue and remainder of my property and estate, real and personal, which I now possess or may possess, and whether situated, I give and devise to my other two children, Sue W. Hines and Fannie W. Perkins, share and share alike. It is my will, however, and I hereby direct my Executor as hereinafter named, that if the share of each of said three children to whom I have devised and bequeathed my said home farm and household furniture contained in the dwelling thereon, when taken at the value placed upon the same as herein provided, and the inventory filed in my estate, shall exceed the value of the share of each of my said two children, Sue W. Hines and Fannie W. Perkins, in the rest residue and remainder of my said property and estate, then I direct my said three children, Jennie Wilkins, Grace Wilkins and Edward M. Wilkins, shall pay to each of my said two children, Sue W. Hines and Fannie W. Perkins, such sum or sums as will equalize the share of all my children in my whole estate, based upon the valuation of the same as herein above provided, and I do hereby charge my said home farm called "The Maples" with such payment or payments, which said sum or sums, shall be a lien on my said home farm called "The Maples," and shall bear interest beginning one year from the date of my death until paid, and the payment thereof shall be evidenced by a good and sufficient release to be duly executed and delivered by my said children, Sue W. Hines and Fannie W. Perkins, and recorded among the Real Records of Kent County. If, however, the share of each of my said three children, Jennie Wilkins, Grace Wilkins and Edward M. Wilkins, to whom I have given my home farm and household furniture, as aforesaid, at the valuation aforesaid, shall be less than the share of each of my said two children, Sue W. Hines and Fannie W. Perkins, to whom I have given the rest, residue and remainder of my property and estate, as aforesaid, at the valuation aforesaid, then I direct that my said two children, Sue W. Hines and Fannie W. Perkins, in that event shall pay to each of my said three children, Jennie Wilkins, Grace Wilkins and Edward M. Wilkins, such sum or sums as shall equalize the shares of each of my five children in the whole of my property and estate, when taken at the valuation as herein provided for its ascertainment, and I

## FIRE CO. TO STAGE BIG SHOW MAY 4-5-6

The Chestertown Volunteer Fire Company, at their regular meeting on Monday night, made arrangements to stage a big benefit show, at the Lyceum Theatre, on May 4, 5, 6, and have engaged the Wheeler Producing Company, of Pennsylvania, professional producers, to stage the show.
