



YOUNG BALTIMOREAN WINS PRAISE AS MUSICIAN

To the syncopated strains of a college orchestra, led by a Baltimore boy passengers aboard the steamship Berengaria will dance this summer as the great liner plows her way back and forth across the Atlantic between Europe and America.

Between trips this same young Baltimorean will wield his baton in the colorful setting of a Paris cafe, and evoke from his college chums that genuine American jazz which is the despair of the classicists and the delight of the boulevardiers.

The Baltimorean is John D. Redue, a graduate of the Baltimore City College and son of Henry O. Redue, president of the Old Town National Bank. The college orchestra is "The Rambler" Keydets" of the Virginia Military Institute, of Lexington, Va.

The orchestra is composed of ten students. Although they have been playing together only two years they have given many concerts at various places in Virginia and have been acclaimed wherever they have appeared.—Baltimore Sun.

Imprisoned For Reckless Driving

Frank Smith, a Negro, 1755 North Woodstock street, Philadelphia, was taken into custody by the Delaware State Highway Police shortly before noon Friday at Station No. 2, St. Georges, charged with reckless driving. The Negro, in a high-powered car, bearing a Pennsylvania license, was "hogging the road" near the Maryland town when he forced Dr. H. P. Copeland, a prominent Chestertown physician, to drive his car into an embankment in order to avert a casualty, according to Sheriff W. W. Goodman of Chestertown.

The doctor's car was not damaged, and no one was hurt. The Negro continued to drive his auto roaring up the road. According to Sheriff Goodman, a Maryland motorcycle policeman gave chase to the terror-car, trailing it nearly to New Castle.

The Delaware police were notified, and shortly before noon Corporal Cole, who had been on the lookout for the speed-demon arrested the man. The speedster was brought here for a trial in Chestertown on a reckless driving charge. He was sentenced to pay a heavy fine or 30 days in jail. He chose the jail sentence.
