A man by the name of Ray, from Texas, left home a few weeks ago in search of his long lost son. He wandered about the country following the trail of a boy until he reached Virginia, where he learned that his boy had left for Salisbury to join the police force. On his way to Salisbury, however, in company with two other men coming to Maryland, they spent the night in a freight car. Their rest was disturbed by an officer, who promptly took them before a magistrate and Mr. Ray says when he left he was minus \$10—a very dear night's lodging.

After paying his fine he had but \$10 left. He managed to reach Salisbury, but when he got there he found that his son had been transferred to Cambridge. Between walking and getting a lift in automobiles, he finally reached Cambridge, only to find that his son had been transferred to Chestertown.

Determined to find him, the journey was resumed. Last Saturday he passed through Easton and begged his meals along the road. Very few people would take him in, he says, thinking he was a tramp. He applied to many people just outside of Easton for a night's lodging and something to eat. He was turned down by all of them and then spent the night in the woods near Wye Mills.

Sunday morning, however, he went to the home of Mrs. B. D. Wolcott, near Wye Mills, and asked for some-

thing to eat. He was gladly taken in and made comfortable. While talking to Mrs. Wolcott he told her of his search for his son, and said he thought the boy was at Chestertown.

At this point Mr. Wolcott telephoned to Chestertown for the State policeman to come to Wye Mill at once, as he was needed on some important business. The motorcycle soon was seen approaching the house, and when the young man walked in the door he was surprised to see his father. The old man accompanied the son back to Chestertown, and is staying with him. The son was so well pleased with the kind treatment of Mrs. Wolcott that he returned a few days later to express his appreciation.

Mr. Wolcott offered the father a home until he could get something to do. This was before he knew the man was looking for his son. Mr. Ray says he is an engineer, but his age is against him getting a job. Throughout the country younger men are being given the preference.—Star-Democrat.

Mr. Ray is now living happily with his son in Chestertown.

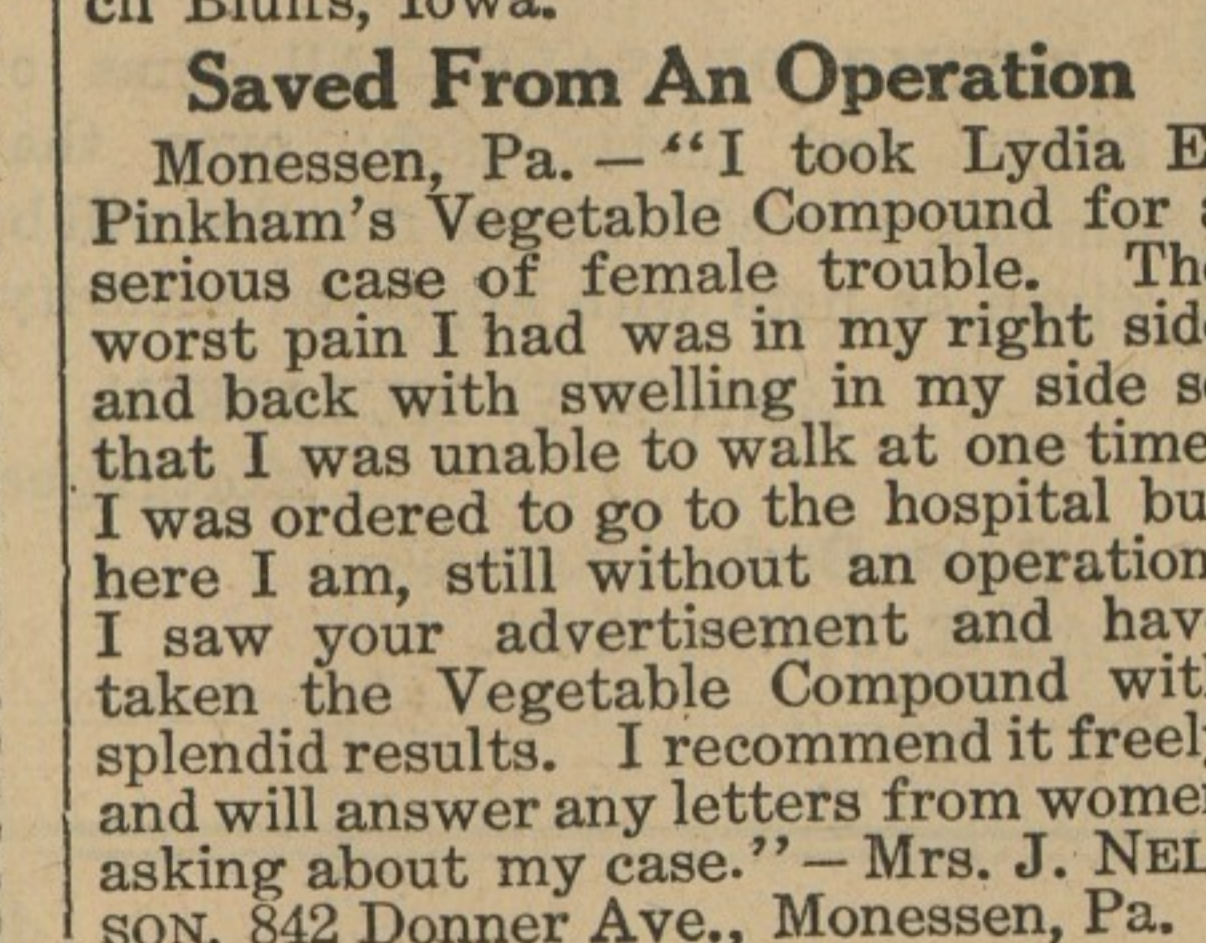

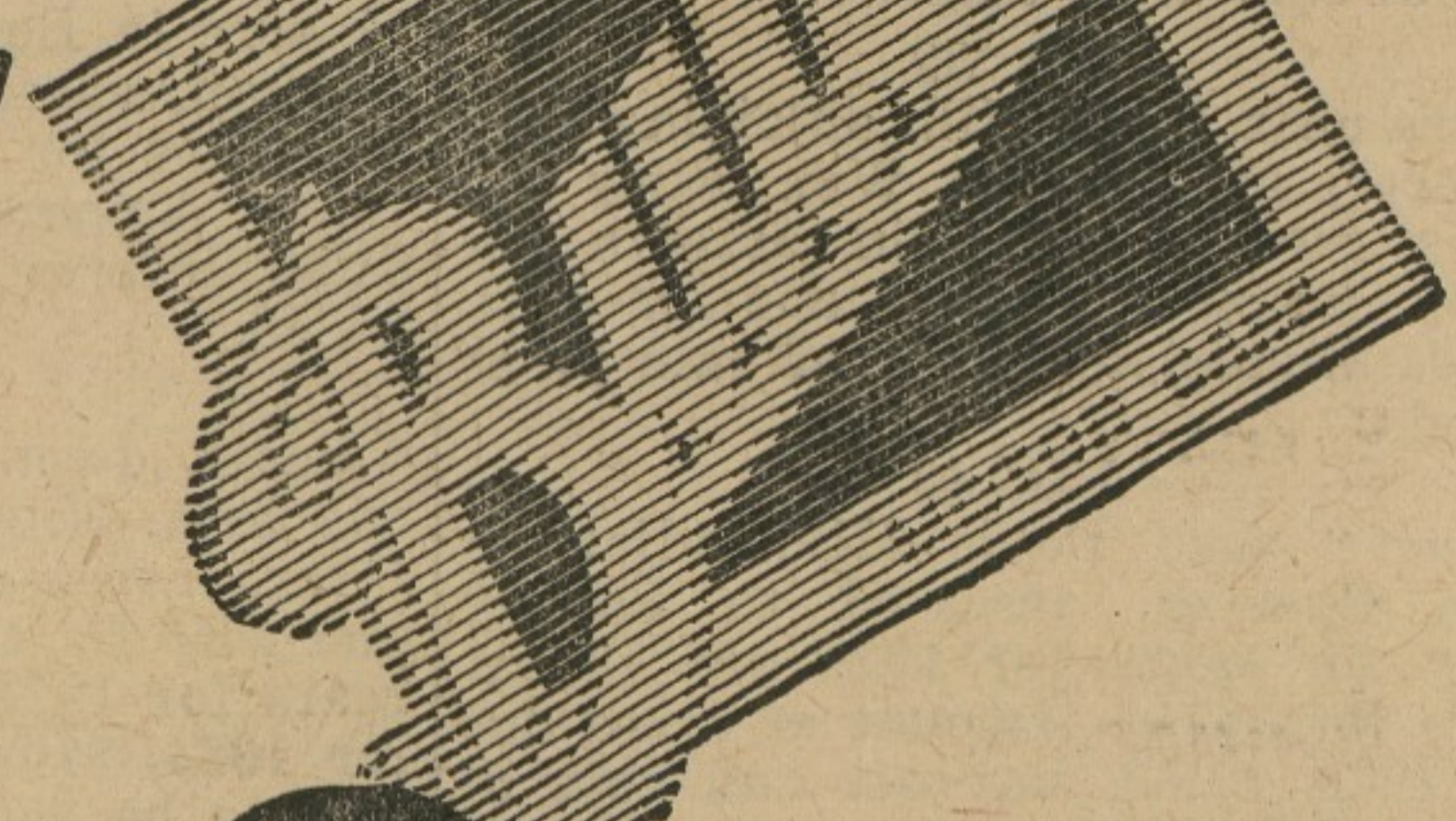
