### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

A competitive examination was given by the Board of Education of Kent County, Maryland, at the Chestertown Elementary School building on Saturday, June 27th, 1925, for scholarships at St. Johns and Blue Ridge Colleges, St. Mary's Female Seminary and The Maryland Institute for the Promotion of the Mechanical Arts.

All four of the applicants who took the examination were interested only in the scholarship at St. Johns College. They were Stanley Matthews, Still Pond; Chester Davis, Galena; Marion Rosen, near Sassafras; and Richard W. Comegys, Millington. Unless some boys and girls in the county become interested in the scholarships at the other three schools before the end of vacations Kent County will not have any representatives at those institutions next year.

Richard Comegys, of Millington, obtained the highest score in the examination and was therefore awarded the State Senatorial Scholarship at St. Johns College by the Board of Education at their meeting held on the morning of Tuesday, June 30, 1925. This scholarship entitles the winner to tuition, board, fuel, lights and laundry for the next four years.

There was also vacant a "Tuition Scholarship for Kent County at St. Johns College and that was awarded to Marion Rosen who stood second in the examination.

### Thick Of Battle Is Shown With Vividness

"Powder River" Contribution To Chronicles Of History.
