## Dr. Perry's First Report

[Sent by Washington College Publicity Service, Chestertown, Md.]

Dr. Albertus Perry, field vice-president of Washington College, who is conducting a party of twenty-five students on an educational tour of Europe, recently sailed with his charges on the Cunard liner "Aquitania" from New York.

Says Dr. Perry, "Last week I had a ride on the "Queen of the Chesapeake Bay," the Tolchester steamer "Express." This week I am spinning eastward on the "Queen of the Atlantic," the "Aquitania." On our trip from Chestertown to Baltimore the "Express" carried a full complement of 3500 souls and the famous Commander on this trip has to her credit the same achievement. Her capacity of 4000 is taxed to the utmost by the boat, being a very spacious one, knows no such thing as a crowd.

I have just finished reading the morning paper, the Daily Mail, published in London and printed on the boat. It is a 24 page affair with all the news, as an Englishman interprets the word. As for passengers, a short time since I finished a game of shuffleboard. My partner was a Jew and my opponents were Jews. But that is not all. This is the year of jubilee for our Roman Catholic friends and they, too, are on the way. One man has a party of 62 from St. Louis, all going directly to Rome to see "Papa," as the Italians speak of the Pope. And then I have my own flock gathered from Texas, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and New York. We, too, are on a pilgrimage; modern Crusaders bound for Golgotha, Bethany, Nazareth Galilee—places associated with the life of the Jew who has made Catholicism and Protestantism facts in the history of religion.

A closer analysis of my fellow passengers reveals some interesting people. I find some Catholics in the steerage and also in the first class cabins, second and first classes and, among my own Protestant ministers, Presbyterians, Methodists—both North and South—Baptists, Episcopalians and others. Then again, a large student body—some from this university and some from that, usually with a professor in charge. A successful effort is being made to make foreign travel an educational value, hitherto little thought of. Evidence of its success are everywhere apparent.

While reading the morning paper I find that Mr. Duke has added \$2,000,000 to his recently large gift to his University, in connection with our own venerable seat of learning surely some day some one will see the opportunity and improve it!

## NEW ROAD TO BE OPENED JULY 28

Millington To Sudlersville Form Another "Shore Link" Between North And South—Ritchie And Mackall To Be First Over Road.

Under direction of State Highway Commissioner John N. Mackall, plans are under way by the Sudlersville Chamber of Commerce for a big celebration of the completion of a new highway between Millington and Sudlersville. This will mean the opening of a fine boulevard between the North and South.

Incidentally, it is believed that this celebration may play a part in the next Democratic campaign. Governor Ritchie, who many think will be a candidate for the United States Senate, is expected to make an address at this celebration, and Commissioner Mackall, whose name has been frequently mentioned in connection with the Democratic gubernatorial nomination, will have general charge of the event.

Plans for the celebration, as far as they have gone, include a parade over the new road about 2 p. m., and the program will be similar to that carried out so successfully last year, when Severn River bridge was opened. The celebration will take place Tuesday, July 28th.

This boulevard—a direct route between Maryland and Delaware—will be welcomed by tourists, who, instead of driving from Elkton through Chestertown, Centerville and Easton, will be able to travel from Elkton to Galena, thence through Massey, Millington, Sudlersville, Barclay, Ingleside and Goldsboro, down the Shore to Ocean City and points South.
