NEW OYSTER RULES HAVE BEEN ISSUED FOR KENT WATERS

Health Board Adopts Regulations For Control Of Industry In Future.

A. L. Sullivan, Commissioner of Food and Drugs of the State Health Department, announced this week, after a meeting of the State Board of Health, that the following new rules had been approved by the board for the control of the oyster industry:

"The covers of all cans containing oysters must be securely sealed by soldering or crimping, and the cans themselves must be stamped with the name or code number of the packer.

Metal Equipment Required.

"All shucking houses will be required to have hot and cold water under pressure.

"In handling oysters there must be no dipping from tubes or other receptacles.

"Packers will be required to have all metal equipment in handling of shucked oysters.

"All unnecessary handling (by hand) of oysters is prohibited and forbidden.

"Hot water, sinks, paper towels and soap must be provided for employees of shucking houses.

"Storage rooms and bins for unshucked oysters must be so constructed as to prevent any contact of oysters with drainage.

To Send Rules To Dealers.

"Shell oysters for the retail trade must be packed in new boxes or barrels and new burlap must be used as a covering for such boxes or barrels.

"The washing of oyster boats with polluted harbor water is forbidden."

Mr. Sullivan said copies of the new regulations, which will supplement, not supplant, the old regulations, will be sent to all oyster dealers.

Schools of New Zealand

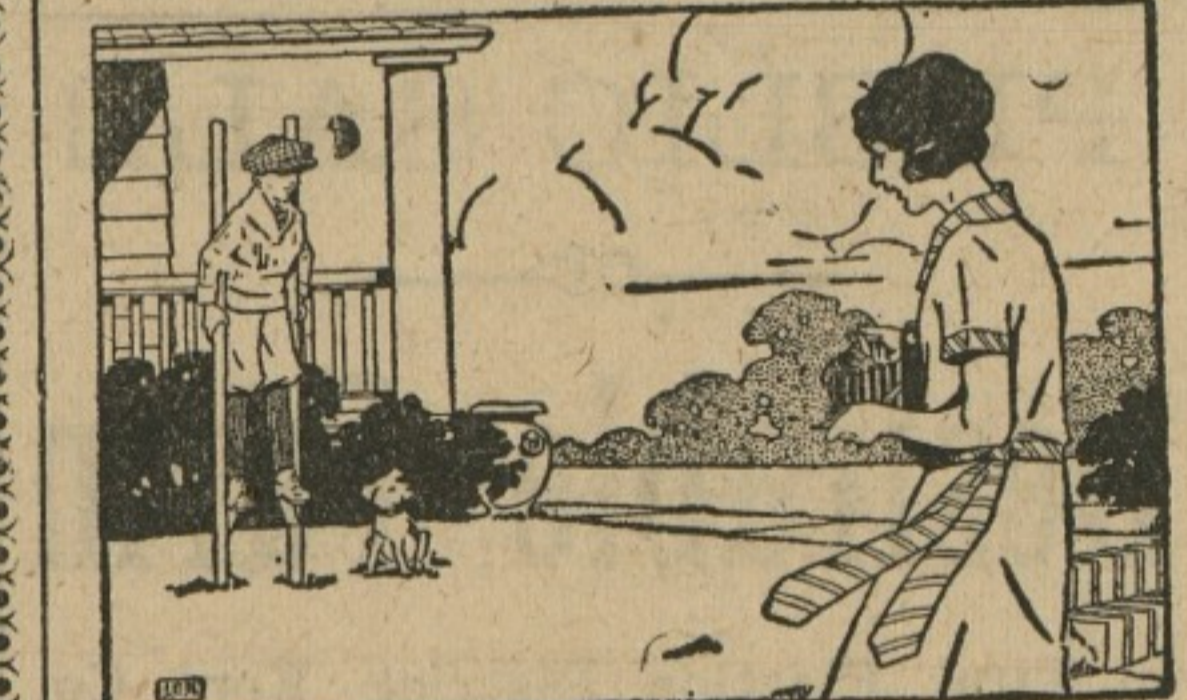
