SCHOONER LOADED WITH WHEAT DESTROYED

The schooner "Thomas C." owned by Frank P. Conroy, of Chesapeake City, after being loaded with wheat last week for Baltimore, shortly after leaving Shallicks' wharf, Sassafras river, was discovered on fire. The fire originated in the engine room and spread so rapidly that the engineer barely escaped to the deck ahead of the flames which drove Capt. John Baily, Jr., and his crew to the life boat, forcing them to leave their clothing, money and personal belongings to be destroyed.

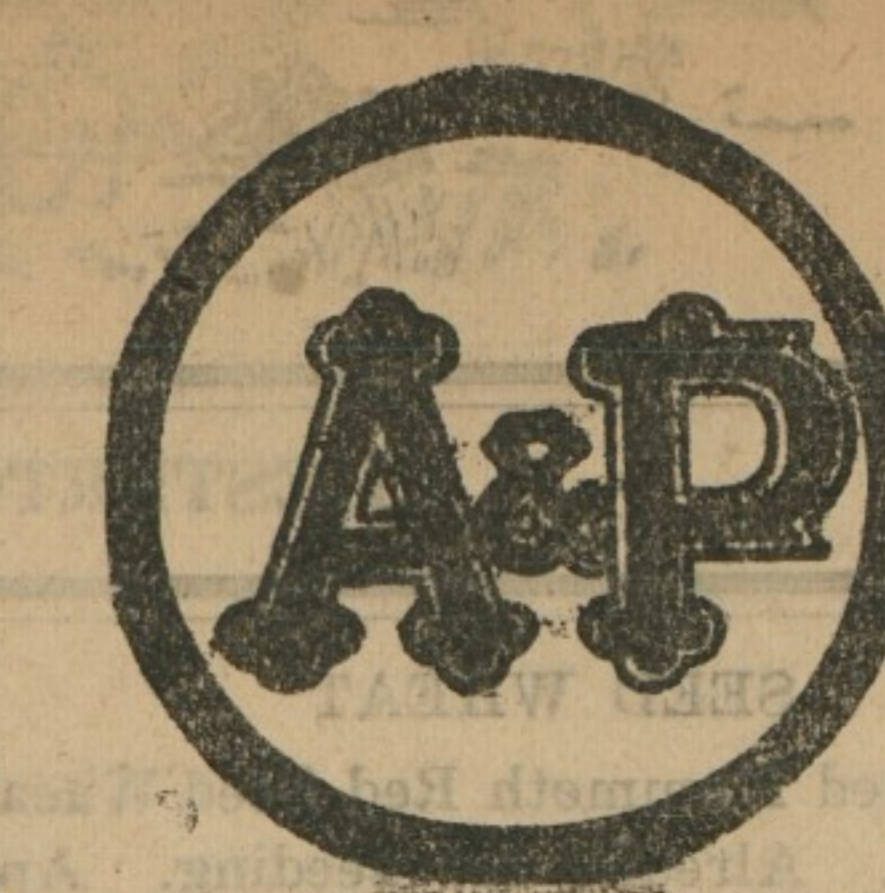

A great many are under the impression they are exempt from securing licenses on account of the law reading that the license does not apply north of a line drawn from Ricketts Point to Love Point. This is in error as there can be nothing north of such a line, the line itself running due north and south. This Department therefore expects to enforce the provisions of the law requiring the above mentioned fishermen to license and Captain Akers of the Local Police Boat has been instructed accordingly. 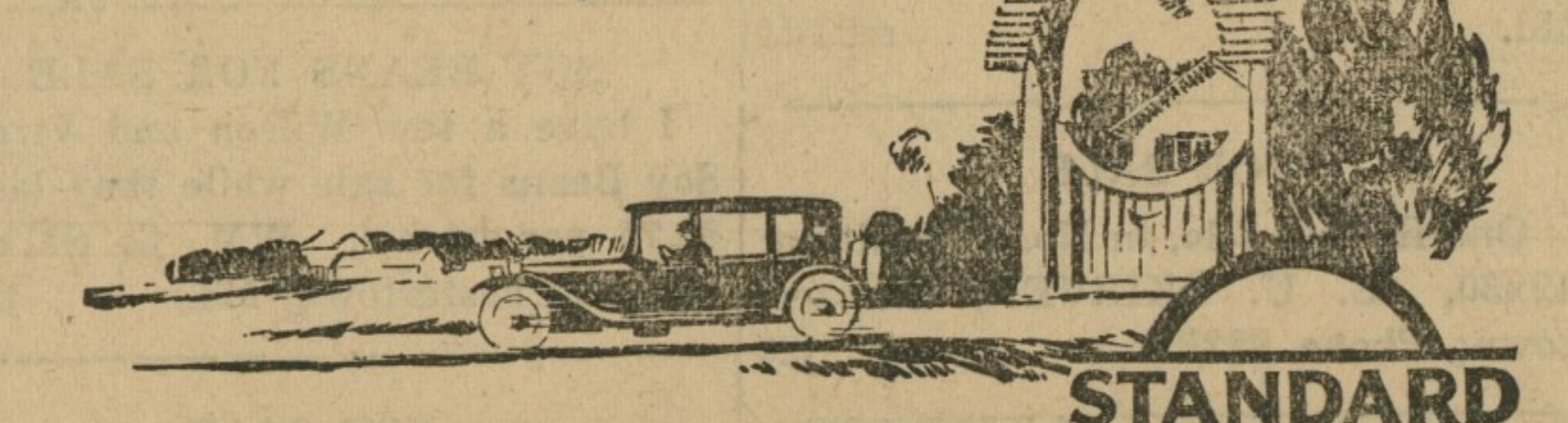

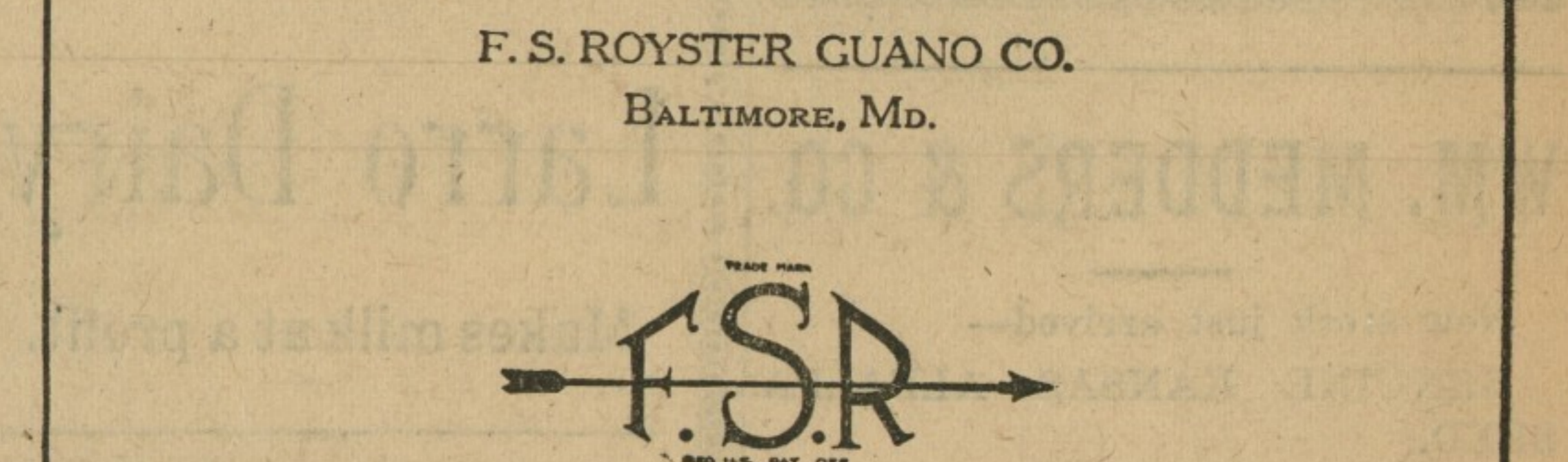
