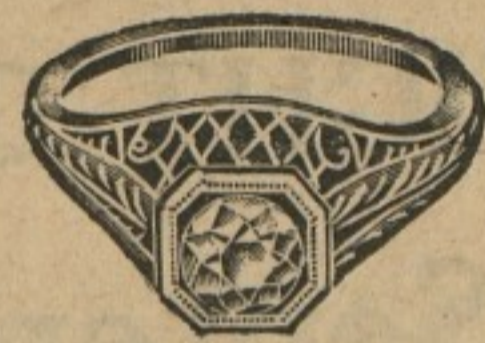

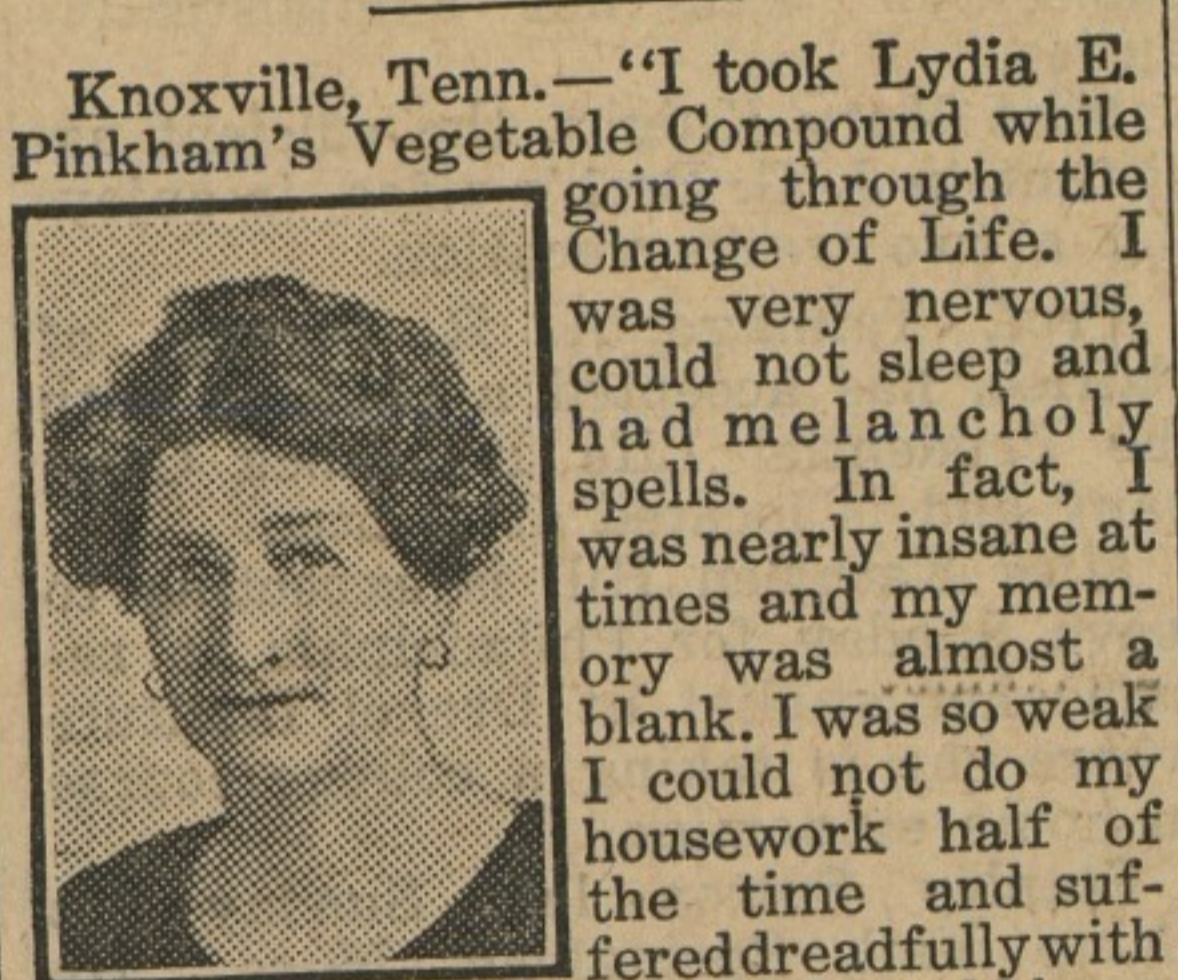

COLLEGE MEN RIDE CAMELS

This is the eighth and last article from Europe written by the Washington College field vice-president of Chestertown, Md. Upon his return he gave a summary of his views on European conditions in general. Writing from Marseilles, France, Dr. Perry says, "Before I leave the boat 'Cor-diere' at Marseilles, August 16, we shall have migrated 10,000 miles. On a steamer to Paris for a week's stay there; then for home! I now write of an experience in Egypt, through many others would be equally as interesting had I the time to describe them. But, for an American at least a camel's ride is unique. It was planned in this way; first, a fifteen mile ride, south of Cairo, along the west bank of the Nile to Memphis, the capital of ancient Egypt. There is not time to record what we did in that city except to state that we deserted our Chevrolet for a more popular mode of travel, the ever present camel. North and south along the edge of the Sahara Desert to the Great Pyramid, twelve miles away; that was our objective. Some of us were afraid it might prove an ordeal beyond reason and I must confess that, for a novice, it did look full of evil forebodings. A camel does not at first glance seem to be a graceful creature but if you know how you may stick. And we stuck. Some found the going better while the beasts were trotting or cantering but a camel does not like to accelerate. Walking is his habit. We needed the inevitable Nubian stick; boys who live in the desert and who meet no one but tourists; knowing nothing about such up-to-date institutions as schools. Their sole code of ethics is to talk to please the tourist. They have christened their camels such names as Missouri, Yankee Doodle, Moses, Cleopatra, et al. They run along by the side of their favorite animal over these twelve miles of sand, for fifty cents and all the while talk anything to please you. Meanwhile the camel pleases you. His exercise seldom seen before. They may complain when they kneel to unload but otherwise they utter not a sound. We made the journey in two hours and a half and were physically none the worse. I believe we were willing to go farther and as for the camel he has no end of endurance. Two drinks a week suffice him and any sort of fodder seems to satisfy his cast iron stomach. For lunch he relished our cast of watermelon rinds. As compared with the Palestine camel he lives on "Easy Street" for he loves the sand. Camels are everywhere in the Holy Land but their lot is a hard one in the stony fields. The camel boy loves gay decorations for his faithful steed while he himself carelessly wears but one garment, a black gown. So that the camel is caparisoned like unto a circus outfit; colored beads and equally highly colored saddles with an abundance of tassels. Occasionally we stopped en route to make observations from the sand hills while our four cylinder animals improved the opportunity to rest. From the archives of their hidden recesses that overworked grub. It was a long journey along that camel's neck and his jaws gladly reciprocated. When ready to continue the journey, the camel returned the cud to its inner abode. At the end of this epoch-making trip we found fourteen beautiful tents just to the west of the Great Pyramid. Here comfortable cots, Egyptian rugs, candies and in fact a full equipment for our convenience were furnished. Best of all we had real hot course meals in a spacious and yet cozy mess tent. In the evening we looked to the east, across the Nile, and saw the many colored lights of Cairo but we were content to rest that night on the quiet sands while guards kept the vigil. The morning brought a new program. This is the last of my letters before sailing for home. They have been written on the run and many scenes and experiences have not been mentioned. Upon my return to Chestertown I am ready, through the courtesy of Washington College of which institution I am an official, to address lodges, churches, clubs and schools, especially on the Eastern Shore of Maryland. For such service there will be no charge whatsoever save the assurance of a greater loyalty to the one college in our fair section of the great State of Maryland.
