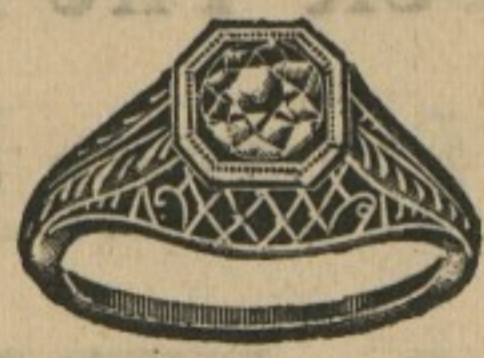

## REGULATIONS FOR Wharves in Kent County, Md.

Adopted by the County Commissioners, September 15, 1925.

**WHARFAGE**  
The rates of wharfage at any of the wharves shall be as follows:  
All vessels lying at a wharf shall pay a fee of \$5.00 per day of 24 hours or portion thereof, except when loading or unloading cargoes.  
Charges upon power boats making regular stops at any of the wharves may be arranged by special agreement with the Wharf Master or his representative.

Cement, per cubic foot ..... 2 1/2c  
Coal, per ton, 2000 lbs. .... 20c  
Fertilizer, per ton, 200 lbs. .... 10c

Fruits and Vegetables, hamper. .... 20c  
Grain, per bushel ..... 1/2c  
Laths and Shingles, per 1000 ..... 10c  
Lime, per ton 2000 ..... 20c  
Lumber, manufactured, per 1000 ft. B. M. .... 50c  
Machinery, per cwt. .... 5c  
Merchandise, per cwt. .... 5c  
Sand, Stone and Gravel, per ton of 2,000 lbs. .... 15c  
Wood, per cord ..... 10c

Said charges to be paid by the boat when freight is shipped or received from any of said wharves.

The County Roads Engineer shall be the Wharf Master for all public wharves in Kent County.  
Effective October 1, 1925.

## MARYLAND PRIEST TO MARK JUBILEE

On October 14th Rev. Chas. P. McGoldrick, pastor of Mother of Sorrows Catholic Church, Queenstown, and Holy Family Church, Church Hill, will celebrate his twentieth anniversary as pastor of the three Queen Anne's county churches. The celebration will be held in Mother of Sorrows Church, Centreville, and about thirty priests from all sections of the Wilmington diocese will attend. Immediately after the 11 o'clock mass, when the Rev. James Grant, pastor of St. John's Church, Hockessin, Del., will deliver the sermon, and the Rev. James Earner, of Chestertown, will be master of ceremonies, the visiting clergymen will be entertained at dinner at Hotel Alexander. Father McGoldrick was born December 19, 1873, in Wilmington, and is a son of the late Bernard McGoldrick and Jane Cassidy McGoldrick. In 1895 he was graduated from St. Charles College, Ellicott City, and immediately entered St. Mary's Seminary. He was ordained to the priesthood October 14, 1900.

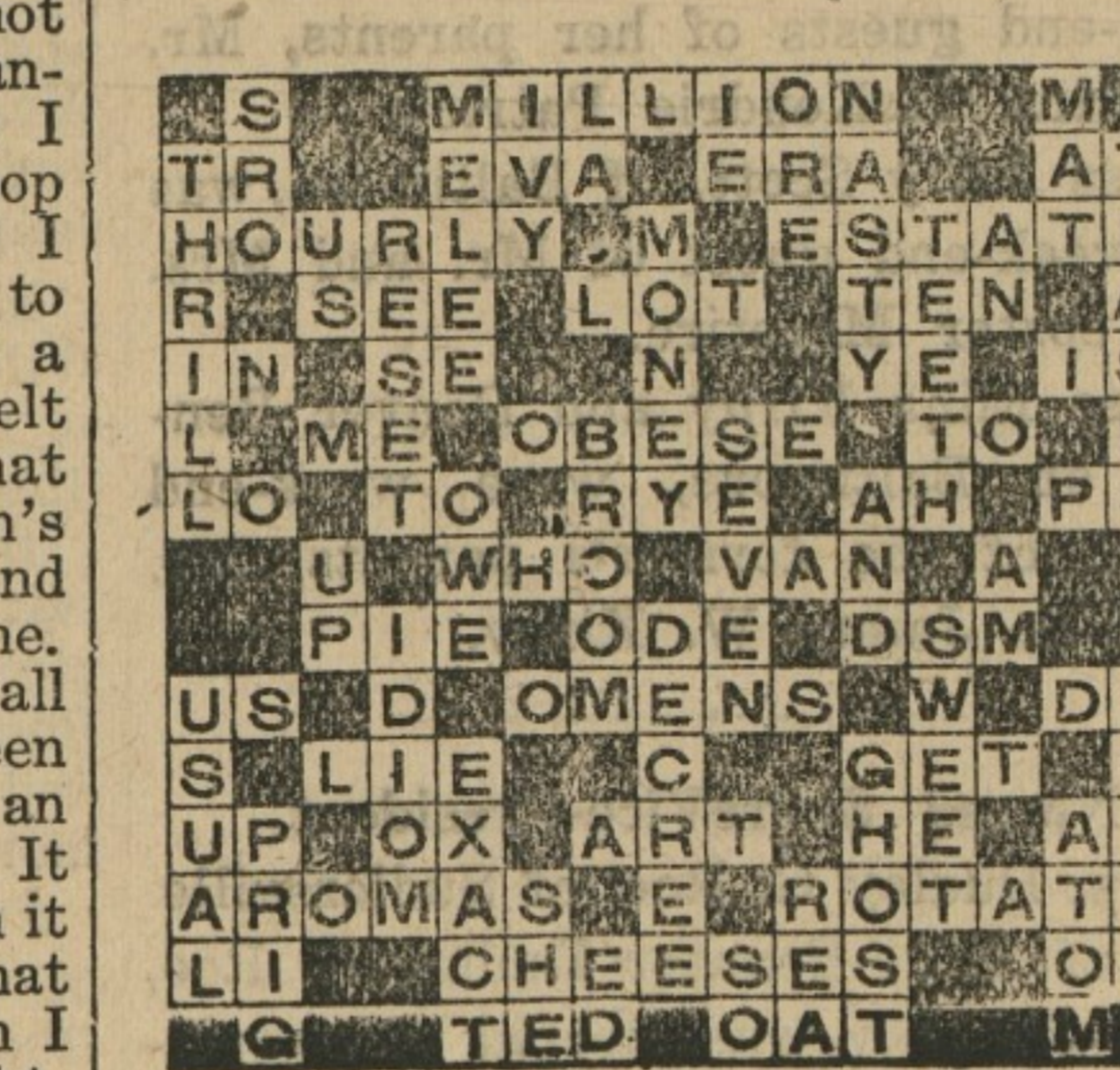
The priest's first charge was on the Eastern Shore and twenty years ago he came to Centreville. He also during the summer conducts services in a chapel at Love Point.

## A 100 YARD DASH

The fleetness of a "human greyhound" recently failed to bear an automobile in a 100-yard dash from a standing start at the Los Angeles Coliseum.  
A half-dozen four-cylinder cars of different makes had been given acceleration tests in 100-yard dashes. The best time was made by a Chevrolet. Each car ran eight sprints over the distance and the results were averaged. The average time made by the Chevrolet was 10.73 seconds.  
The other averages were: 11.13 seconds, 11.19 seconds, 11.28 seconds, 11.58 seconds and 12.54 seconds. The car which ran second and third were considerably higher in price than the Chevrolet.

After the tests, the question arose as to the relative "pick-up" of the automobile and the human sprinter. A contest was arranged in the Coliseum between a Chevrolet and Keith Lloyd, cousin of Harold Lloyd. Keith Lloyd is the champion sprinter of the University of Southern California. The Chevrolet was driven by Dick Champion, former Bucknell University track star. The stop watch was held by Dean Cromwell, Lloyd's coach.

At the starting gun Lloyd leaped ahead of the car. He was in full stride before Champion had changed to second gear. The rapidly accelerating car roared after him, however, and caught him at the tape. Coach Cromwell clocked car and sprinter in a dead heat of 10.3 seconds. On comparative figures, had Lloyd sprinted against any of the other five cars he would have won without extending himself. The speed of the Chevrolet car at the finish was 32 miles per hour.
