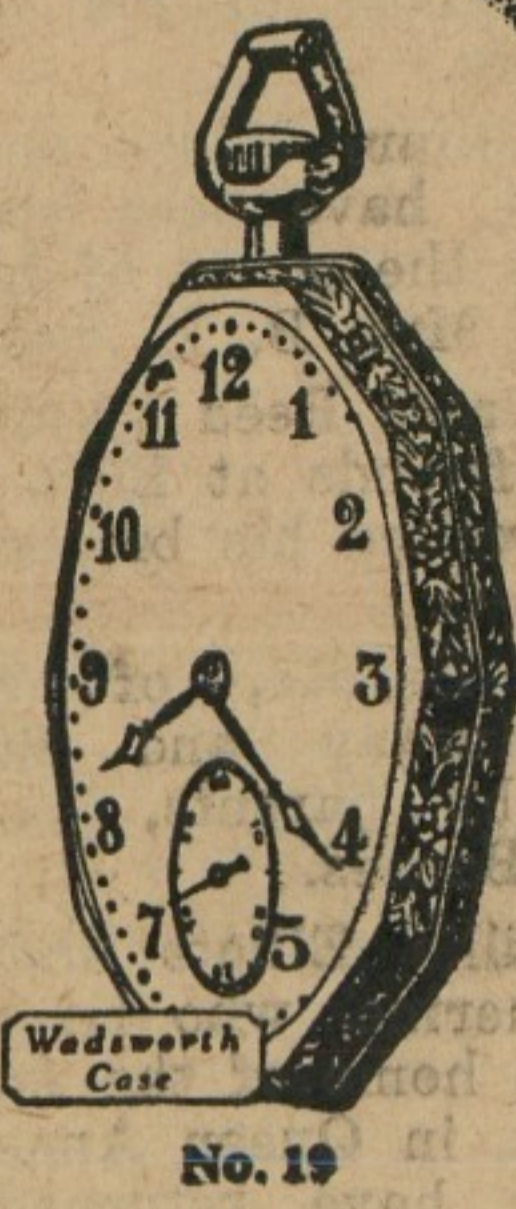

The discussion of the placing of a cannery at Church Hill was taken up. Following some remarks by various members on the necessity for such an enterprise, it was unanimously decided to make the December meeting exclusively a cannery project meeting. Mrs. B. Clay Coppage, Chairman of Women's Work in the County Farm Bureau, directed a very attractive programme in which three Church Hill children took part. The meeting closed at 9.30, declared by all present a business-like and successful session.

Miss Emma C. Shafer, Kennedyville, and E. Thomas Massey, of Massey, have been appointed chairmen in Kent county for Golden Rule Sunday, announces Harold F. Pellegrin, State Director Near East Relief. Similar chairmen are being appointed all over the State, announces Mr. Pellegrin. Golden Rule Sunday, Dec. 6, which has been approved by President Coolidge, will be observed by 60 nations. Its immediate objective is to help feed, train and provide for 33 nations orphans under Near East Relief care, and the event offers, says Mr. Pellegrin, an easy way for everyone to help by serving a simple dinner of Dec. 6 and giving the difference between it and the regular meal, or as much more as may be desired, to aid these little ones.

**SHORE BUS LINE SELLS FOR \$63,000**

The News some weeks ago reported the sale of the bus lines. This sale was approved on Friday by the Public Service Commission. Under the terms of this transaction Red Star Motor Coaches, Inc., associated with Day & Zimmerman, engineering experts of Philadelphia, will take over the property and franchises of the Eastern Shore Transit Company and of Harry T. White.

For the property of the bus company \$63,000 will be paid, it was stated at the offices of the Public Service Commission. This sum, after deduction of outstanding indebtedness of \$30,000, will leave \$33,000, for distribution among the concern's stockholders. For the White holdings \$25,000 will be paid it was said.

The Red Star concern, it was added, will finance by selling 1,000 shares of preferred and 2000 shares of common stock for \$105,000, the issues to be taken by Day & Zimmerman.

Bus lines involved are: Ocean City to Salisbury, Salisbury to Claiborne, Hurlock to Federalsburg, Chestertown to Elkton (temporarily discontinued but to be resumed) Chestertown to Tolchester, Easton via Centreville to Rock Hall, Chestertown to Rock Hall, Betterton Corners to Betterton.

The new traffic signal on High St. attracted considerable attention on Saturday from onlookers but soon after its installation it was quite noticeable that our local people did not grasp what it was about. Those red and green signals meant nothing to them. On the other hand, out of town motorists obeyed the signal to a man. There will be many times when a car will be required to stop on High street for 40 seconds waiting for the signal to change, when there may be another car in sight. We understand it has been installed for experimental purposes only and the best manner in which it can be

made successful is for our local people to obey the signals. Out of town motorists will obey them, and if you don't, there is more danger of an accident than if there were no signals at all.
