This tree would not only beautify the place where it is put but would serve as a constant reminder of the community spirit and it would tend to inspire the children to care for it and protect it and all other trees.

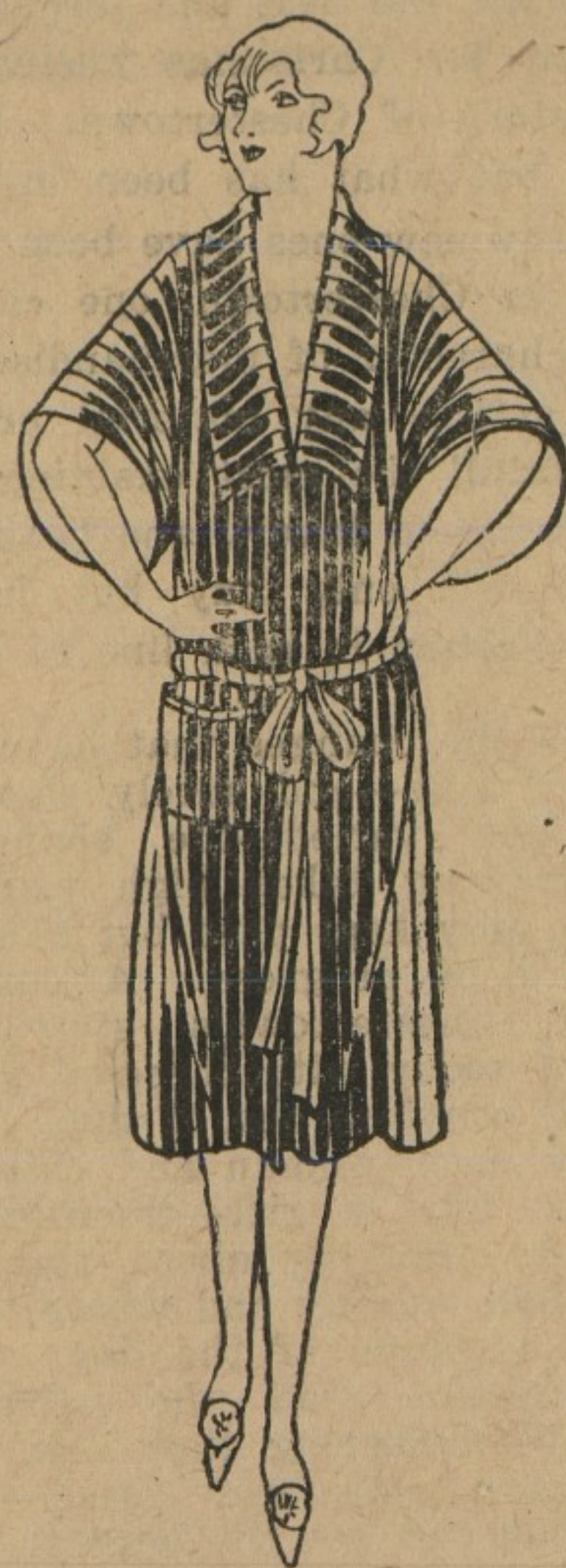
**IN MEMORIAM**

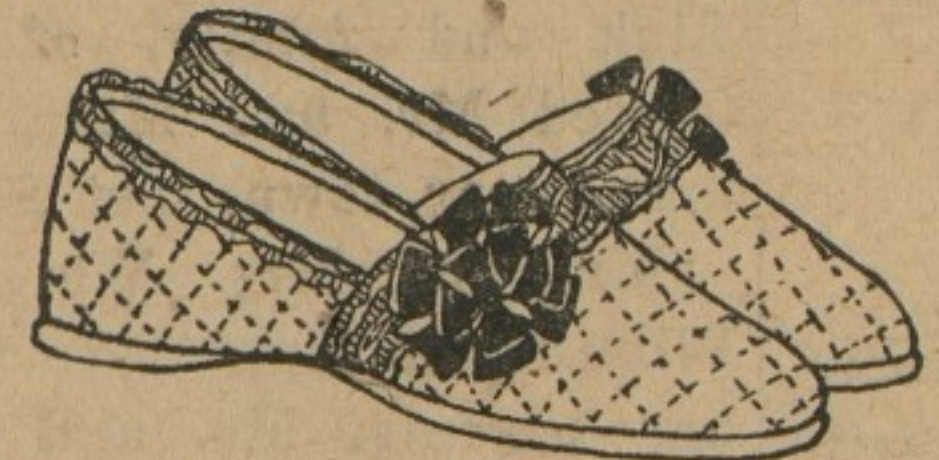

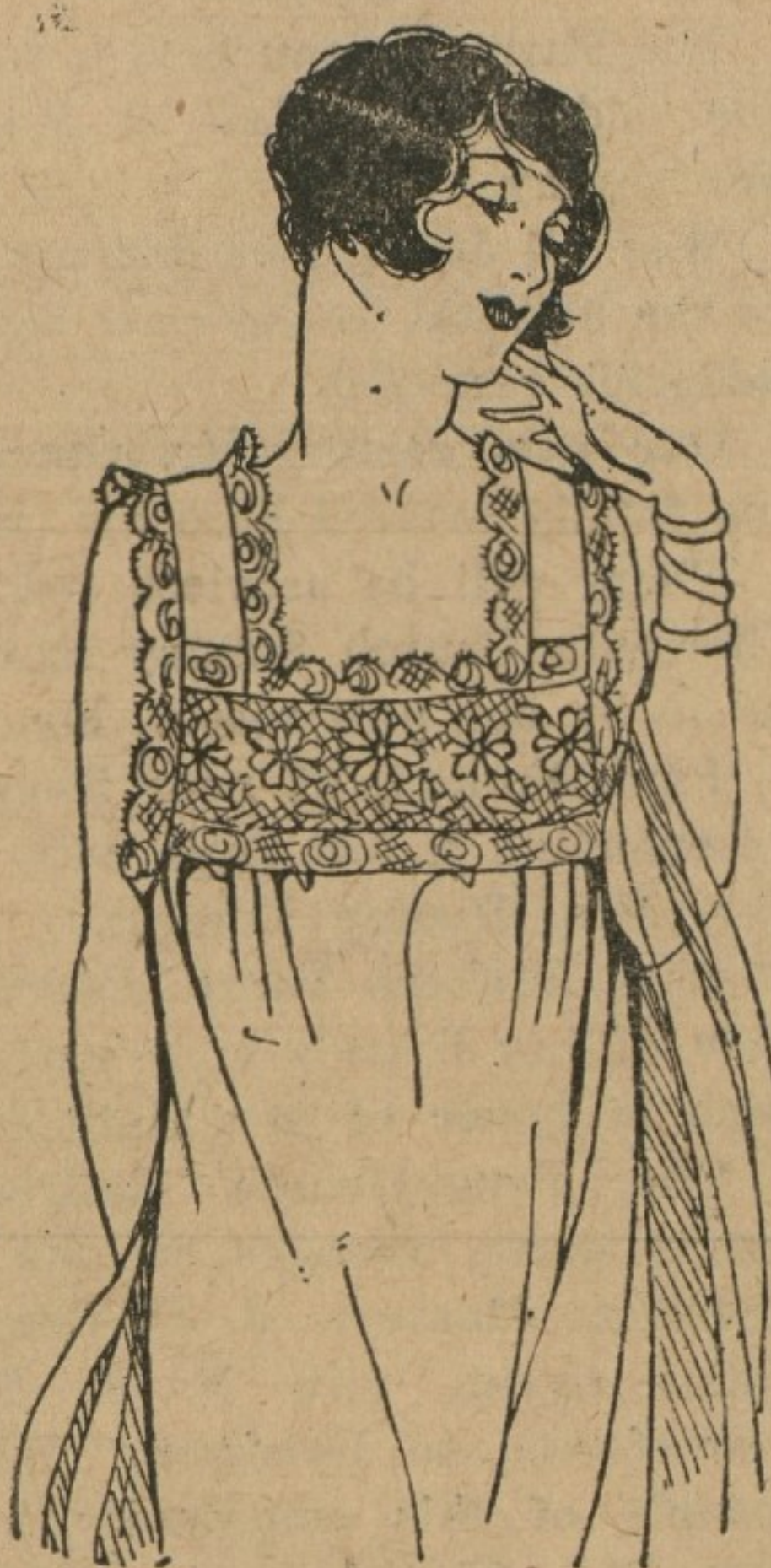

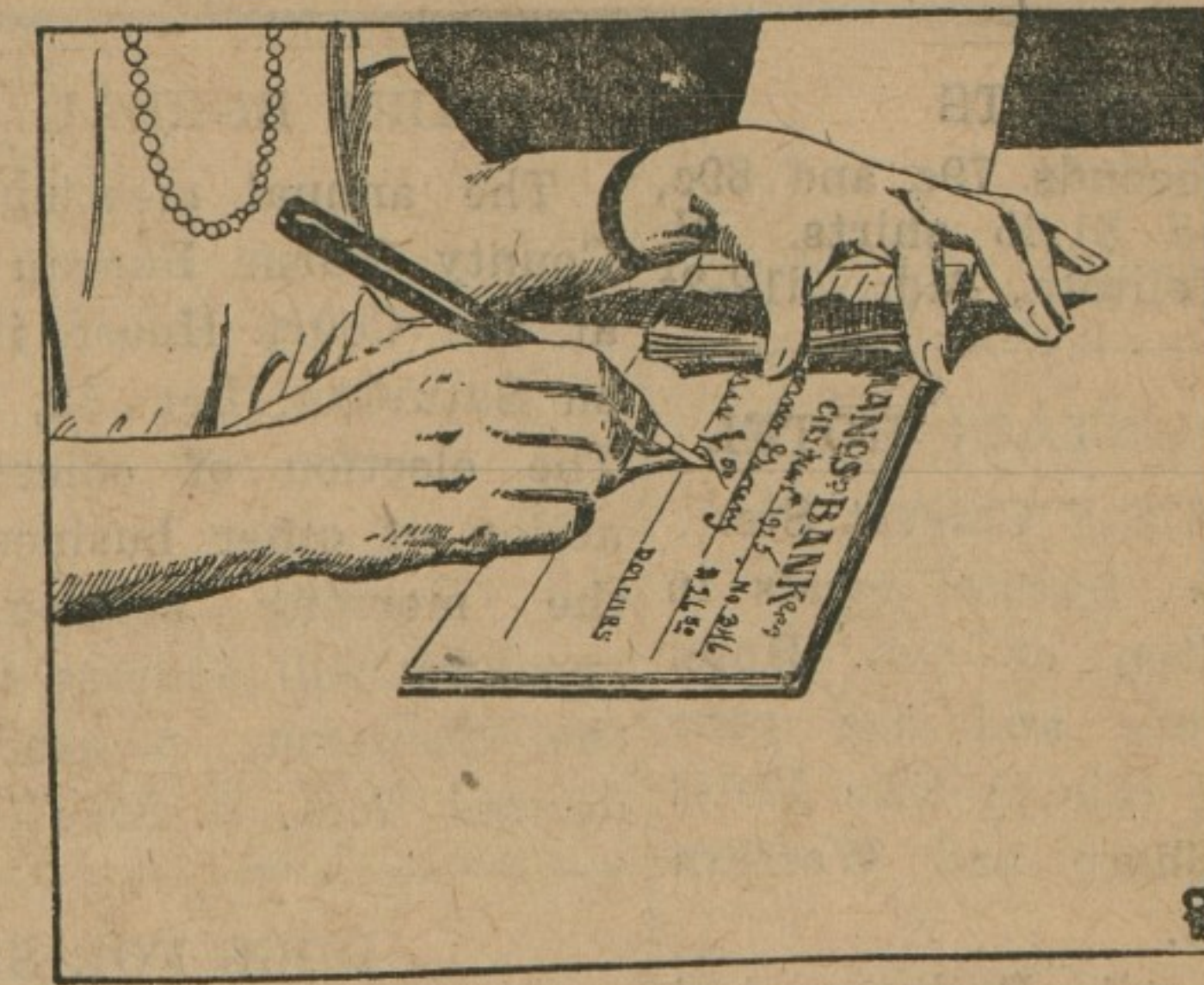
