## LOCATION OF 50,000 BOND IMPROVEMENT

### Bill Being Prepared For Maryland Assembly Ready Next Week

At a meeting of the Town Commissioners this week the program of improvements to be included in the bill for the \$50,000 bond issue was definitely decided upon. Harrison W. Vickers, attorney to the Commissioners is at work on the bill which it is thought will be ready for presentation at the Maryland Assembly next week.

In reducing the amount of the issue from \$80,000 to \$50,000 it was necessary to make some cuts in the improvements at first proposed.

A bill is also being prepared for the \$25,000 bond issue for the sewage disposal plant, recommended by the State Department of Health.

In addition to the following improvements the \$50,000 bond issue will pay off the existing debt of the town:

### SENT OUT INCOME BLANKS

The Collector of Internal Revenue has sent to all who made returns last year, forms for the 1928 returns.

The taxes must be paid by March 15. Shortly after March 1, the staff in the office will be augmented to handle the last minute rush.

The officials are urging every taxable person to make their returns as soon as possible by sending in their returns now.

According to the Federal regulations. An income tax return must be filed by every citizen of the United States whether residing at home or abroad, and every person residing in the United States though not a citizen thereof, whose gross income for the taxable year 1928 amounted to \$5,000 or whose net income amounted to:

- (a) \$1,500 if single or if married and not living with husband or wife;
- (b) \$3,500 if married and living with husband or wife; or
- (c) Regardless of amount if the net income exceeds the personal exemption.

If an individual is single and the net income, including that of dependent minors, if any, is \$1,500 or over, or if the gross income is \$5,000 or over, a return must be filed. If the combined net income of husband and wife, and dependent minor children, if any, is \$3,500 or over, or if their combined gross income is \$5,000 or over, all such income must be reported on a joint return, or on separate returns of husband and wife. In case the husband and wife elect to file separate returns and their combined net income is \$5,000 or over, each shall make a return on Form 1040, even though the net income on

one of the returns is less than \$5,000. "If the net income of a decedent from the beginning of the taxable year to the date of his death was \$1,500 or over, if unmarried, or \$3,500 or over, if married and living with husband or wife, or if his gross income for the period was \$5,000 or over, the executor or administrator shall make a return for him on Form 1040 or 1040A.

"Under each of the above conditions, a return must be filed even if no tax is due.

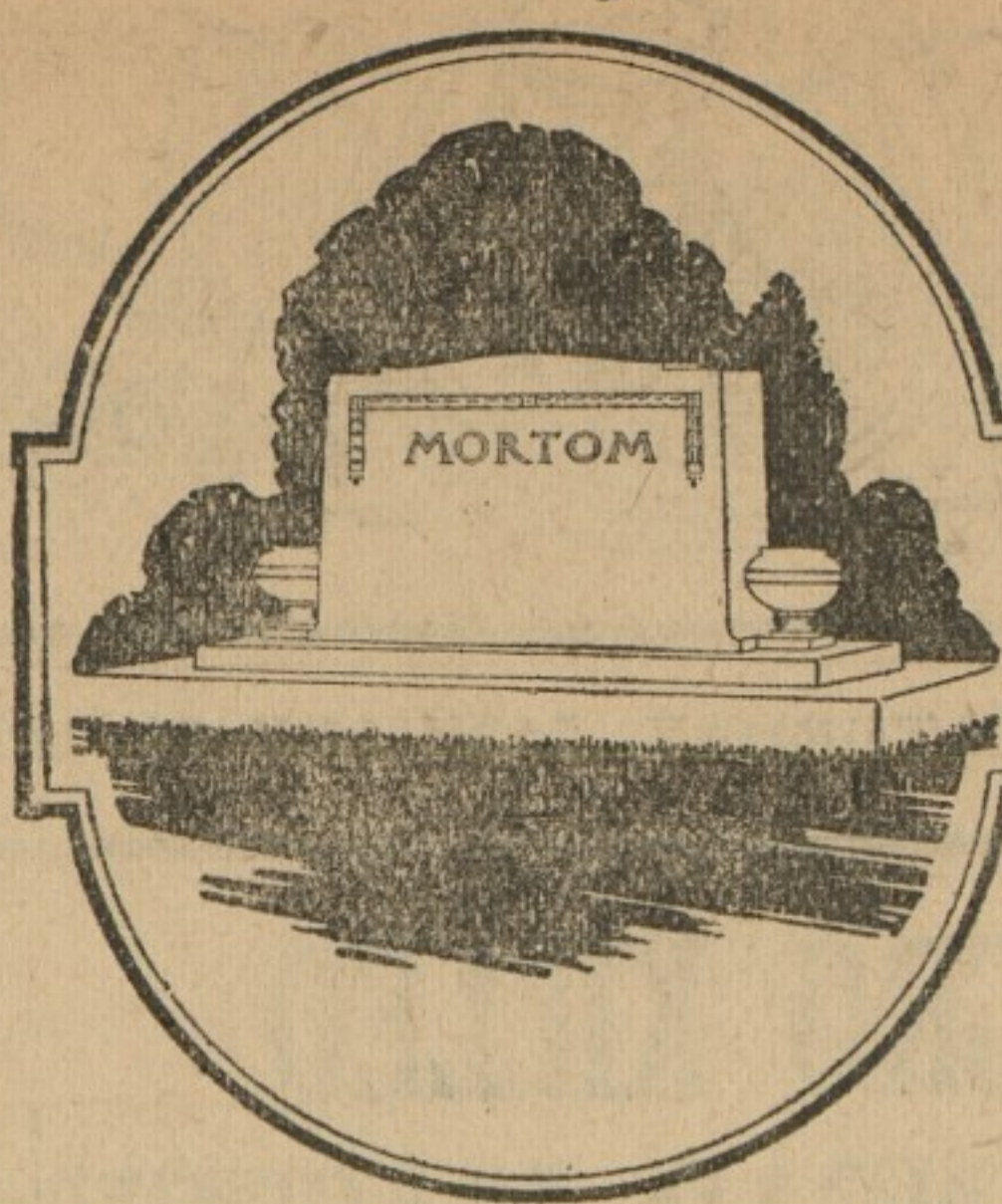
