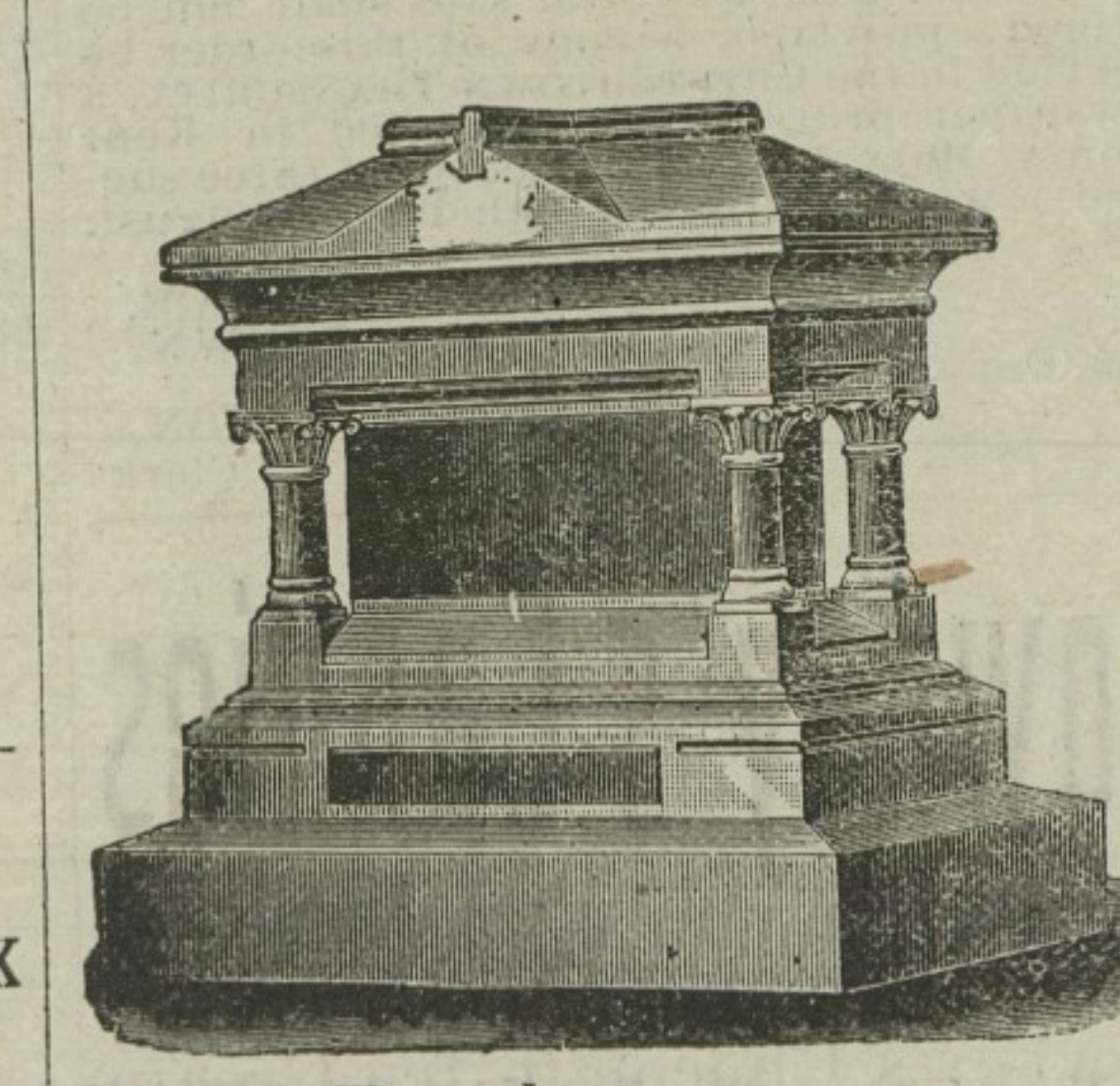

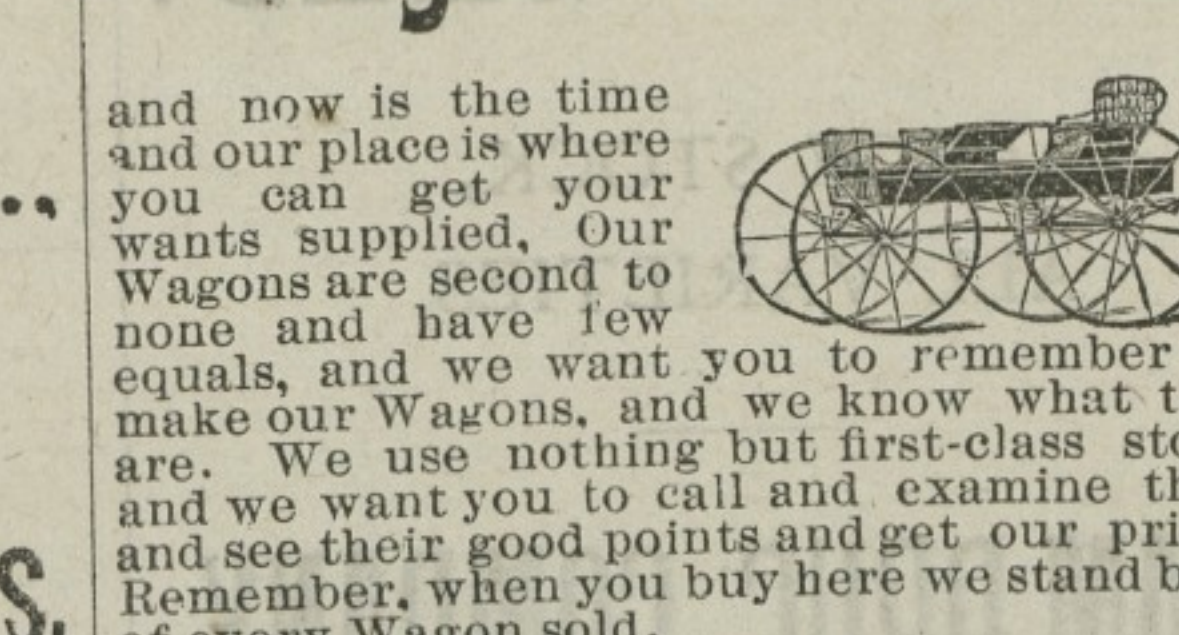

HOW BASEBALLS ARE MADE.

The process of making baseballs on a wholesale plan is a rather interesting one, consuming, in a single season, something like 8,000 skins. The scraps from the shoe factories, of which the "raw" balls are moulded, are stored in cellars of about one acre area, and from this material the balls are shaped by hand.

The newly pressed balls are then sorted and allowed to dry out for a period of from three to four weeks, when their weight is reduced to perhaps five ounces. Something like 200 of these twine-bound leather balls can be found in the bins at all times.

In the meantime the skin covers for the balls have been seasoned and dressed on the floor below, and as a last stage in the process, rubbed back and forth against an upright blade, to take out all kinds in the skins and also whiten them. The covers are cut from the skins by hand and sewn around the balls by women. Each woman is expected to finish fifteen dozen balls daily. From every skin from fifteen to thirty pairs of covers are obtained.
