MRS. ELIZABETH USILTON BACKUS. The Kendall County News, published at Plano Illinois, on April 7th, contains the following obituary notice of Mrs. Elizabeth Usilton Backus, neice of Mrs. James H. Thompson, of this town, and a lady well-known to many of our oldest residents: "Elizabeth Usilton was born at Chestertown, Kent county, Md., Jan. 30th, 1867. She was the oldest daughter of Albert and Hester Usilton. She came to Plano in 1876 with her parents, where she resided up to the time of her marriage to Mr. Frank W. Backus, October, 1887. To them were born three children. For several years the family have lived in West Pullman, where Mrs. Backus died Wednesday morning after months of suffering.

"The funeral services were held at the home Friday morning at 8.30, and were in charge of Rev. Hopkins, pastor of the West Pullman Baptist Church, of which Mrs. Backus was a member, having joined that faith here at Plano. "The remains were brought to Plano on the noon train Friday and laid away in the Plano cemetery. "Mrs. Backus was a zealous christian woman, a faithful wife and loving mother, who will be mourned and missed by the bereaved husband and three little children and the father and mother, and brothers, Warren, Vernon and Harry, and sisters, Pearl and Evelyn. Warren, who lives at Slaughter, Wis., was unable to get here until after the funeral."
