**Good Roads Bids Ordered.**

The State Roads Commission began preparations for active work in the construction of new roads when it ordered advertisements for bids for about 50 miles of roads in 10 counties. It is believed the bids will be opened on May 27 and the contracts let.

The counties in which the work is to begin and the mileage are as follows: St. Mary's—Five and three-tenths miles. Cecil—Three and three-tenths miles. Kent—Three and three-tenths miles, from Chestertown toward Keadyville. Queen Anne's—Two miles, from Centerville toward Church Hill. Talbot—Three miles. Caroline—Five miles. Dorchester—Four and three-tenths miles. Wicomico—Five and eight-tenths miles. Worcester—Five and eight-tenths miles. Somerset—Three and one-tenths miles.

The commission decided to invite bids on stone, gravel, oyster-shell and samptic roads for the four materials will be placed in competition. The samptic road is built of sand and tar, and Mr. Crosby and the commission believe that it can be used to advantage in certain counties. Miles of it have been laid in Massachusetts, at Cape Cod and in California. The roads can be built at a cost of between \$1,000 and \$3,000 a mile, according to materials and conditions.

After the bids are received the commission will determine upon the material with which each road is to be improved and award the contract. By placing different materials in competition the commission believes it will get better prices for all of the work.


