

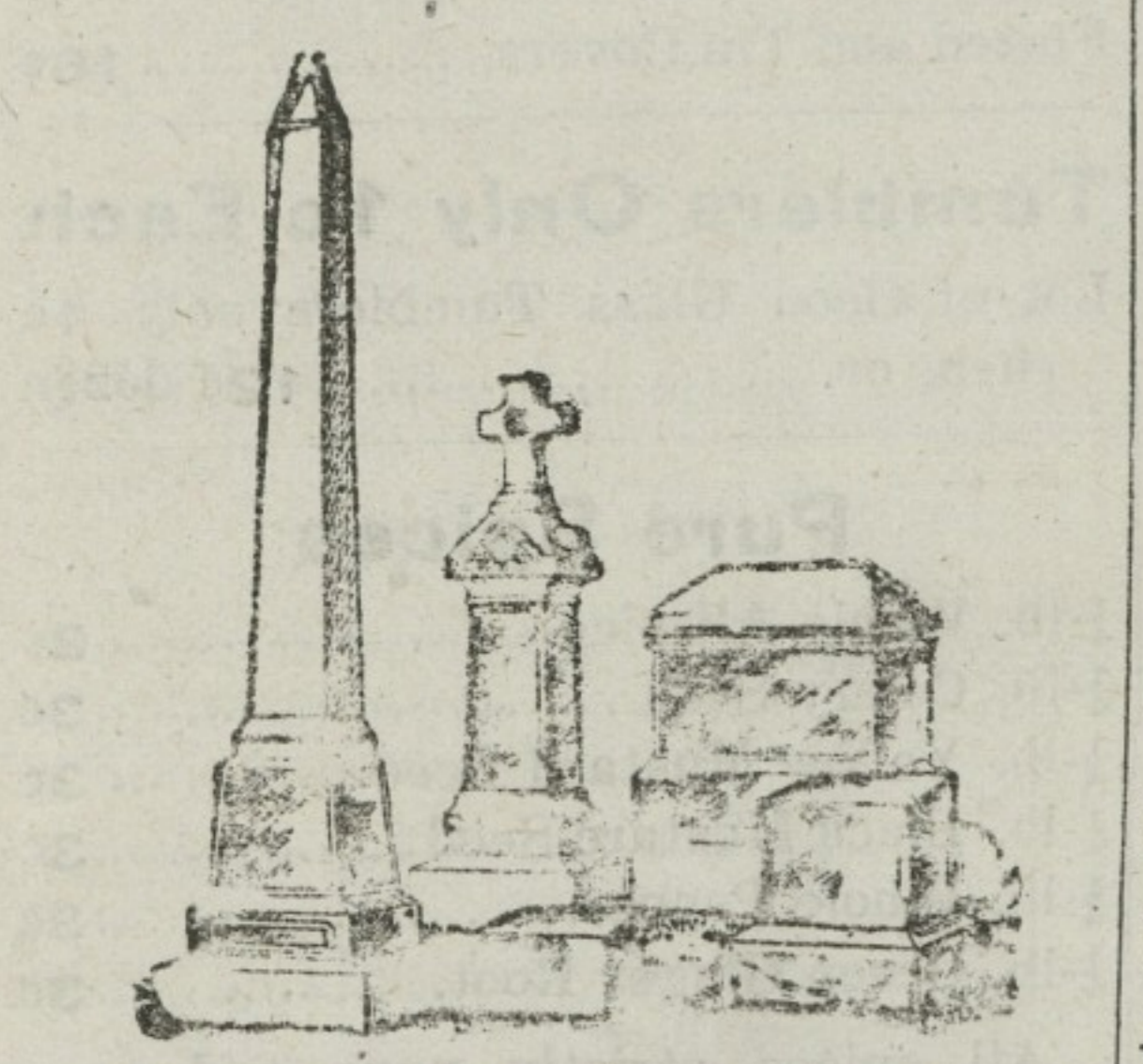

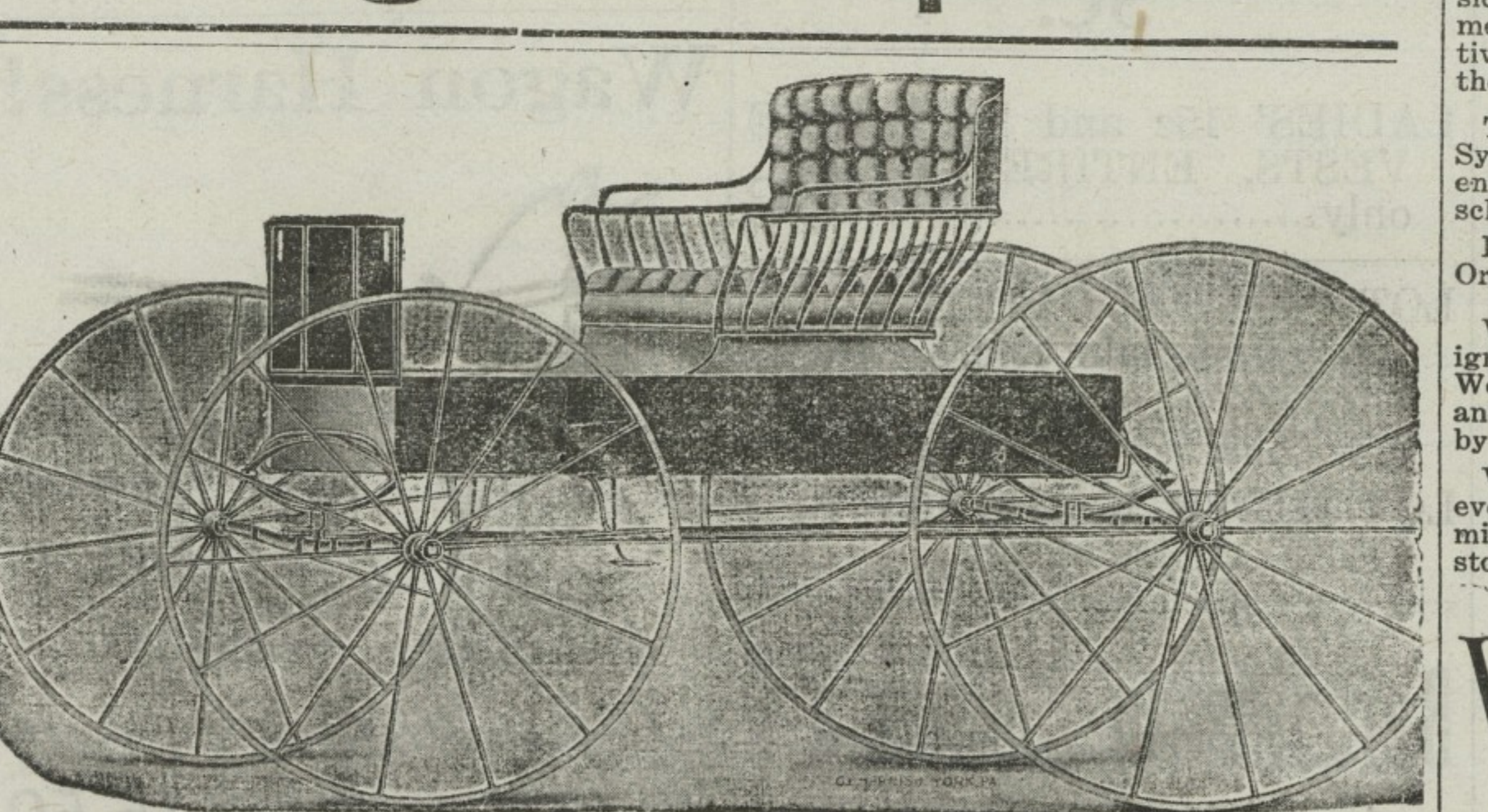

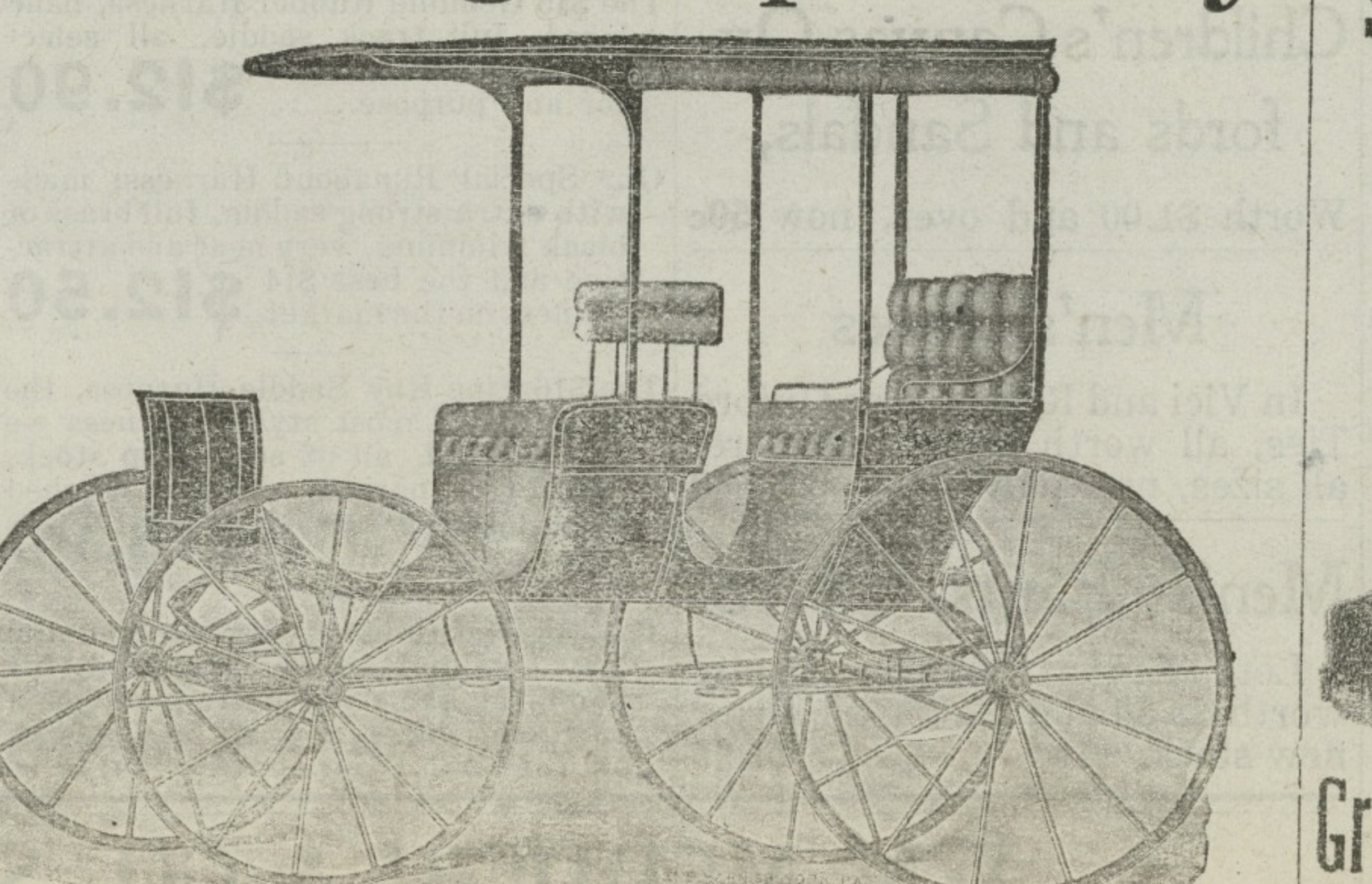

WHEREAS, at the January Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, held in the year one thousand nine hundred and eight, an Act was passed proposing an amendment to Section 1 of Article 1 of the Constitution of the State which Act is in the following words, to-wit:

SECTION 1.
