**FACTS ABOUT ROAD ENGINEER.**  
Powers and Duties, Rights and Privileges as Prescribed by the Law Passed by the Last Legislature.

For the benefit of the tax-payers of the county and others interested in the County Road Engineer and his duties, and who may not have had the time to read the law published in the TRANSCRIPT, we give the following important facts relative to his office and his relation to the Board of County Commissioners:

**APPOINTMENT.**  
He is appointed by the Governor for a term of six years at an annual salary of \$1,600, without any reference whatever to the political opinion of the person so appointed.

**QUALIFICATIONS.**  
He must have a sufficient knowledge of civil engineering to enable him to make surveys, plats, profiles and specifications of or the draining, grading, maintenance repairs and reconstruction of the public roads, and to do the necessary engineering work for the building or rebuilding of county bridges.

**REMOVAL FROM OFFICE.**  
The road engineer cannot be removed from office for any reason other than incompetency, neglect of duty, or misconduct in office, and then only upon the sworn complaint of ten or more resident tax-payers of the county to be filed with the Governor.

**POWERS.**  
1—He has entire charge of the work of repairing and reconstructing roads and bridges, purchasing material, employing labor and teams as he may deem necessary.

2—He appoints all the district road supervisors, who receive \$3 per day for every day's actual work. He also employs all the laborers at \$1.50 per day for every day's actual work. He pays the supervisors less if he can obtain as good service for less. The Road supervisor has charge of work in his precinct or district, but cannot employ any laborer, and is subject to the authority of the engineer.

3—He can spend no more money in any one fiscal year than the county commissioners levy, except with the written consent of the commissioners.

**HIS DUTIES.**  
He must appear before the board of commissioners at their first meeting in every month and make a statement to them of the work done, materials purchased and money expended.

He must examine and certify to the correctness of all bills and accounts for any work done or material furnished on any of the public roads or bridges of the county before the same shall be paid by the commissioners, and said commissioners shall make no payments until such accounts are certified by the Road Engineer.

He must make an annual report to the commissioners of all work done, together with a list of the names of all persons employed on the roads, or furnishing material, and the amount to which each person is entitled, said report to be made on or before the 15th day of June for the year ending on the 30th day of the preceding May.

No new roads may be opened except by application to the county commissioners, and under supervision of the County Road Engineer.

Other minor duties and details affecting the office may be found by reference to the law. The above is the gist of the law.

I—For Kent County Grangers.—For the grange making the largest and best collection \$30.00. Second largest and best collection 20.00.

III—Then the entire grange collection of Kent county is to be put in competition with the entire grange collection of Queen Anne's county, and the county scoring the greatest number of points to receive the grand prize of \$50.00. These classes are separate and distinct from all others and open only to the granges.
