## Notice to Public

No Obstructions of Any Kind to be Placed Upon Highways or Bridges, Roads or Lanes, Streets, etc.

Cannot Obstruct Ditches.

Road Engineer Gives Notice

The following abstract from the road law of Kent county will hereafter be strictly enforced, and all persons and corporations should take warning:

197L. Any person or corporation placing any obstructions of any kind whatsoever upon the public highways or bridges, roads, lanes, streets, avenues or alleys of Kent county, or interfering with or obstructing any of the ditches or drains thereof, or encroaching upon the same with fences or other obstructions, or any person or corporation, its agents or employees exercising the business of a common carrier, permitting his or its vehicles, steam or other engines or cars, to obstruct any crossing for more than five minutes at any one time, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be liable to prosecution, at the instance of any taxpayer of said county, and upon conviction by any justice of the Peace exercising criminal jurisdiction in Kent county, shall be fined in an amount not less than one dollar nor more than twenty-five dollars for each offense. Any person arrested under this Section shall have the right to appeal to the Circuit Court for Kent county for trial, and all fines collected under this Section shall be paid to the said County Commissioners and by them applied to the General Road Fund of this county.

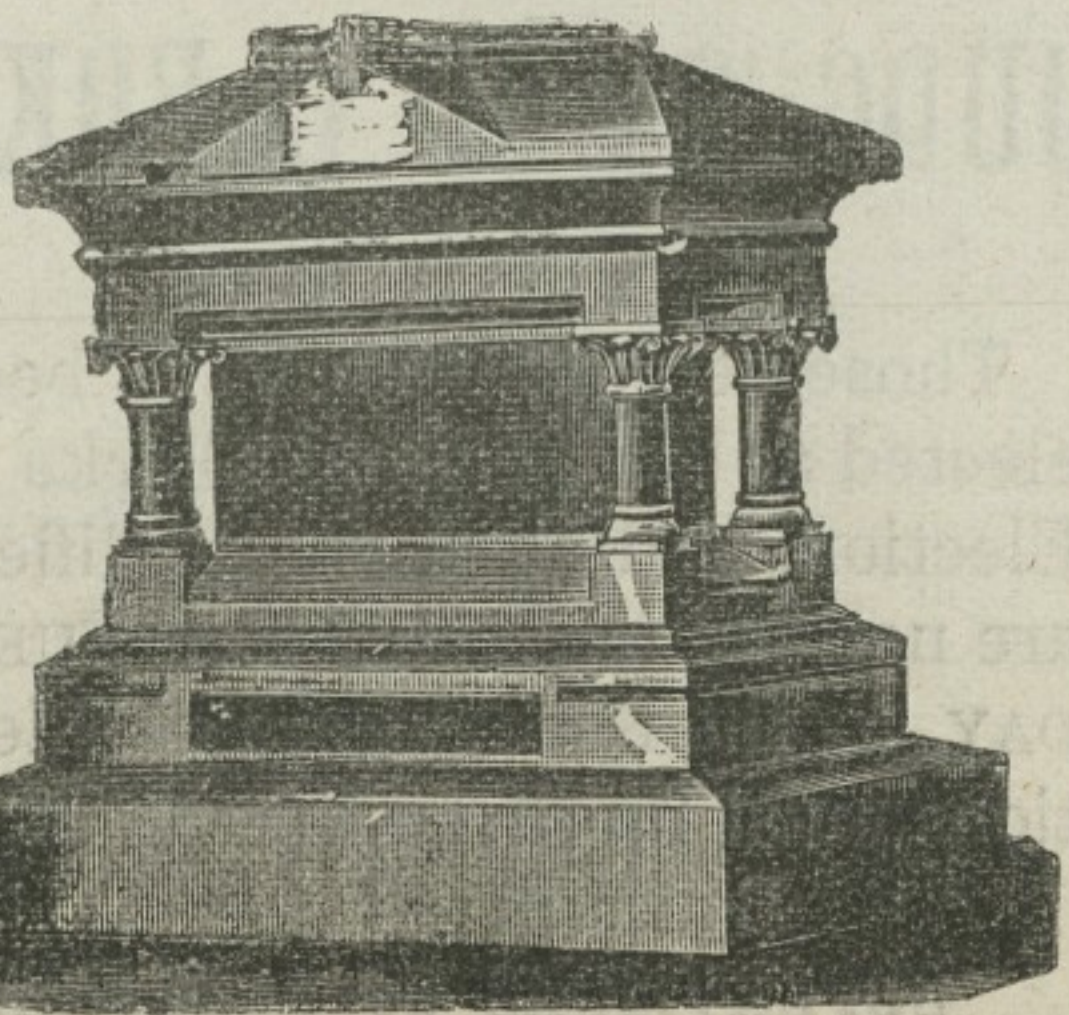

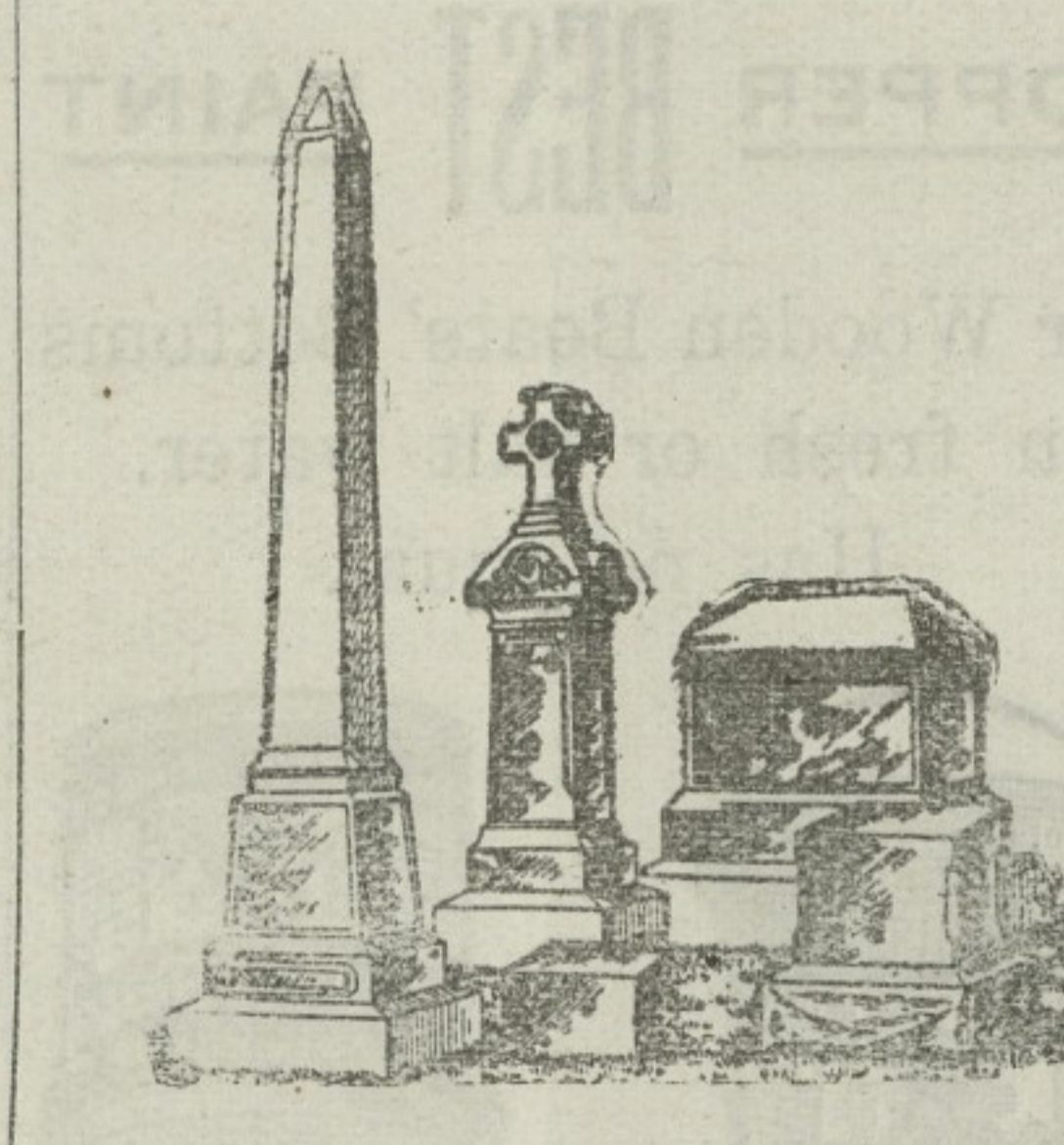

## IN CHURCH CIRCLES.

Rev. Dr. L. E. Barrett occupied the pulpit in Centerville M. E. Church morning and evening in the absence of Rev. W. A. Wise, who has been ill of typhoid fever for several weeks. It goes without saying that the doctor gave the people of Centerville two able sermons.

Rev. Robt. Watt, D. D., district superintendent, preached in the Chestertown M. E. Church on Sunday morning and held quarterly conference on Monday evening. Rev. L. S. Matthews occupied the pulpit on Sunday evening in the absence of the pastor.

"Roll Call Day" will be observed in Christ M. P. Sunday school the first Sunday in October, and a special programme is being arranged for the occasion. All teachers and scholars are urged to remember the date and be in attendance.

The monthly meeting of the Woman's Foreign Missionary Society was held Tuesday afternoon at the home of Mrs. S. E. Ford on Washington avenue. The officers for the year were elected. Miss Minerva Guthrie, a returned missionary from Korea, was present and addressed the meeting. She also talked in prayer meeting Wednesday evening.

The Chestertown M. E. Sabbath School will celebrate "Rally Day" next Sunday Sept. 25th. A special program is being prepared. Solos will be rendered by Messrs. Jas. H. Shuster and Robert W. Bramble. Everybody invited. Come and help revive interest in the Sunday School.

Chestertown M. E. Church.—Rev. L. E. Barrett, D. D., pastor—Services next Sunday, Sept. 25th, as follows: 10.30 A. M., preaching by the pastor—Subject: "The Deep Well;" 2.15 P. M., Rally Day in the Sunday School—Music, addresses, etc.—All the scholars and teachers, and the parents are requested to be present. 7 P. 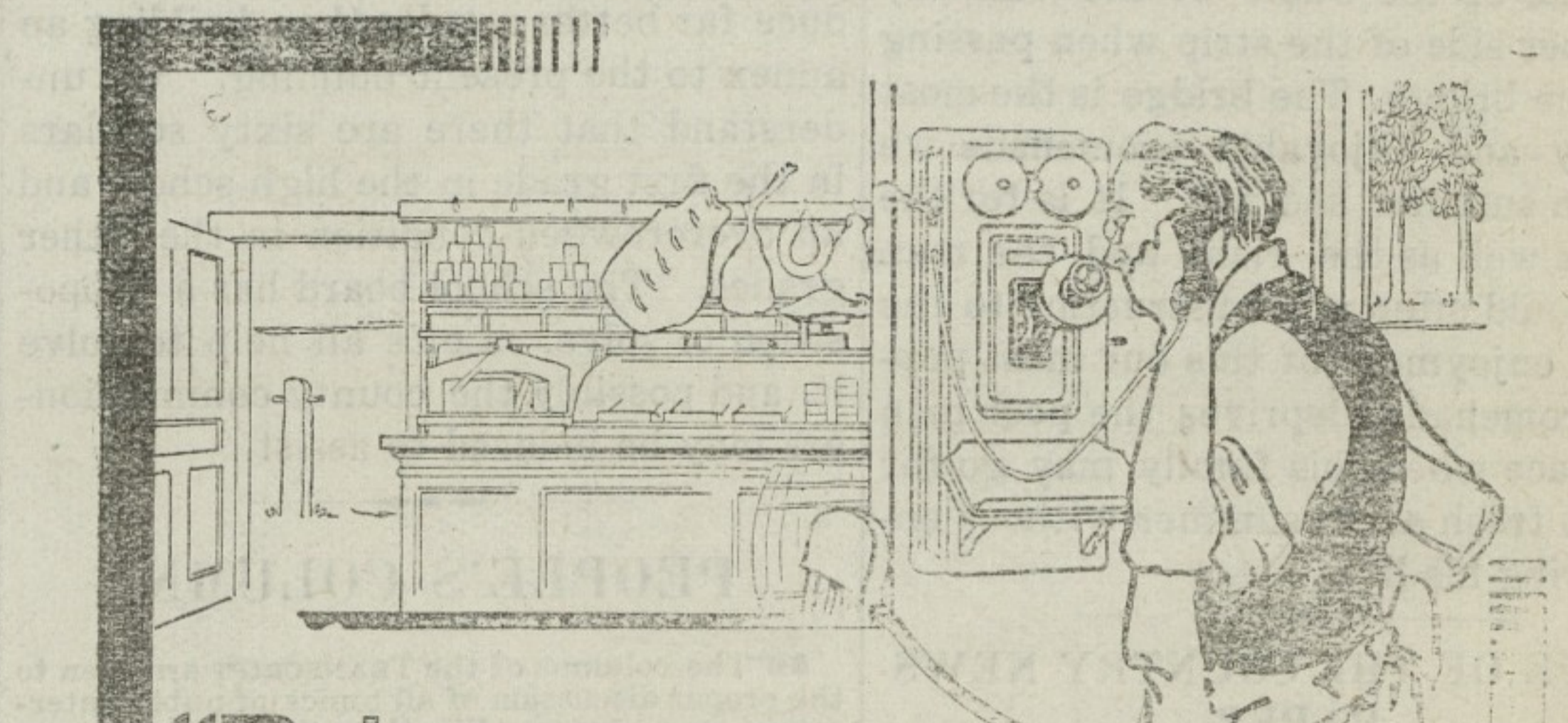

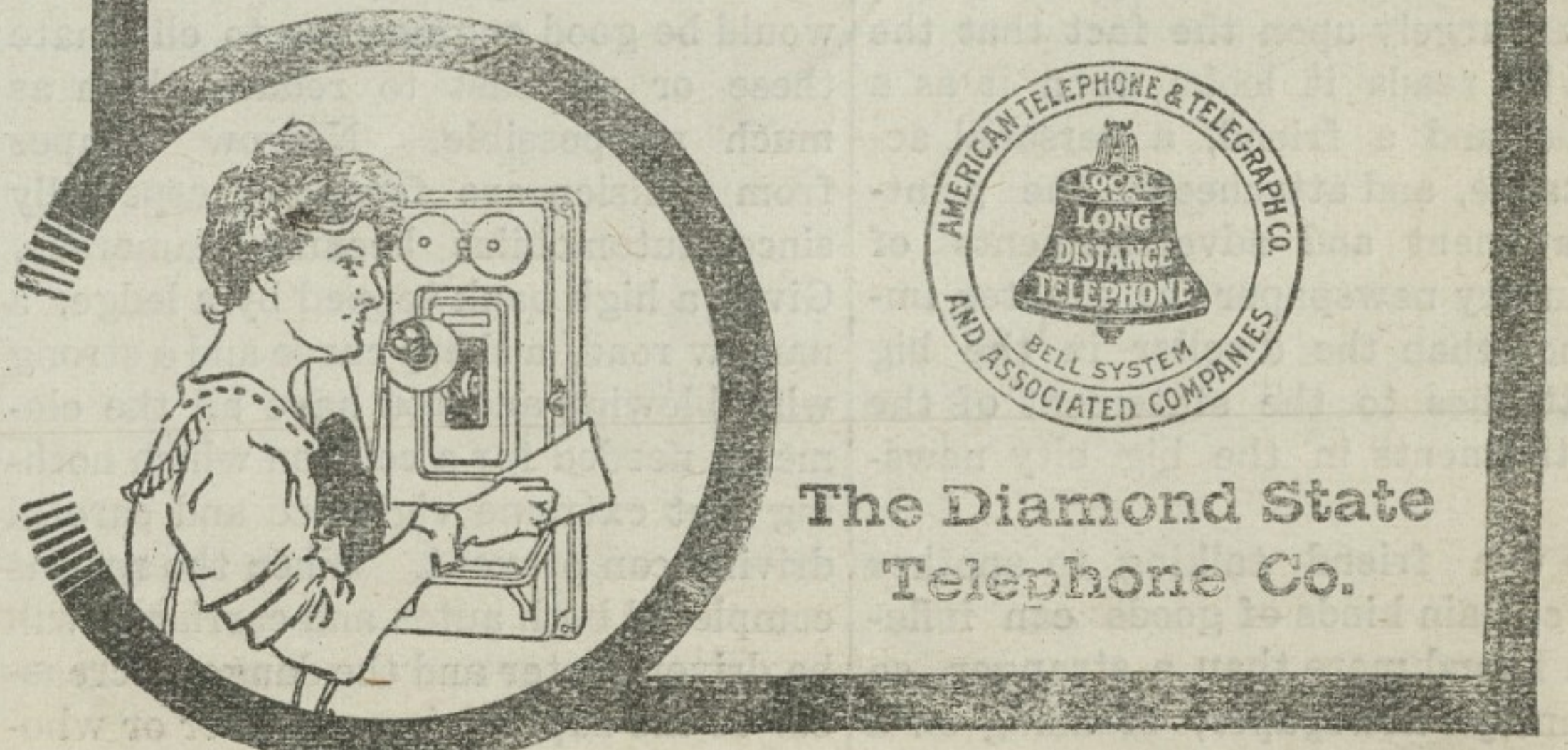
