WE ARE trying to give to the tax-payers in this block a simple explanation of the difference between the Cash Levy and the Certificate Levy, also we are giving you a comparative statement of the indebtedness of the county when the levy was struck in 1910, and what it is today in 1913.

The Cash Levy is to pay cash for the various items as allowed in it; for instance, we strike the levy the first week in June. All allowed in that Cash Levy is paid in cash, or rather, an order on the Treasurer, which is the same. This comes from the taxes he is collecting.

This is not the case with the Certificate Levy, which is nothing more or less than an interest-bearing note for such things as you see published, is for certificates issued from the 10th, 1912, to the time of striking the levy on June 6th, 1913, and are not paid until January 1st, 1914.

Suppose, at the first meeting of this board, which will be June 10th, there should be a bill presented for \$100, there would be added to this bill interest to the amount of \$9.32, for it would not be due until January 1st, 1915, and be provided for at the time of striking the levy in June, 1914, it at that time being a part of the county's indebtedness.

If the above-mentioned bill had been in the Cash Levy there would be no interest.
