The Allies had had the best of the advantage in the great European war during the week.

MUCH of the credit for the showing made by Isaac Lobe Straus in Kent county in the primaries is due to R. Groome Parks, Esq., who conducted a quiet, but effective campaign.

SENATOR SMITH was nominated by a minority of the Democratic vote in the State, and his total vote represents about the Organization strength throughout the State and city.

The State of Maine, usually a Republican stronghold, elected a Democratic Governor on Monday by an increased majority over that given to Wilson in the Presidential campaign, and the Democrats control both houses of the Legislature.

DEMOCRATIC leaders are proud of the fact that President Wilson has been "on the job" during the first 18 months of his term more days than any other President in a quarter of a century.

THE Republican machine in the State is said to be heavily in debt from the last two or three elections. The amounts owing in various banks are put as high as \$40,000.

RESULT OF THE PRIMARIES.

The result of the primary election in Kent county on Tuesday was by no means a surprise to anyone. It was a settled fact in the minds of every one that Senator Smith and Senator Price would win the nomination for United States Senator and Congressman, respectively, and this certainty accounts in a large measure for the unusual lack of interest in a primary contest in Kent, and for the fact that less than 40 per cent. of the registered Democratic vote participated in the primaries.

SMITH AND PRICE WIN

Receive Overwhelming Majorities Over Opponents in One of the Tamest Primaries in History of State.

RESULT NO SURPRISE TO PEOPLE.—KENT GIVES BIG MAJORITIES TO SMITH AND PRICE.

In one of the tamest primaries in the history of the State, Senator John Walter Smith defeated Isaac Lobe Straus for the nomination for United States Senator by 31,000 majority.

CONGRESSIONAL PRIMARIES.

In the fight for Congress in the First District Price has carried every county on the Eastern Shore over James T. Bright for the short term nomination for Congress.

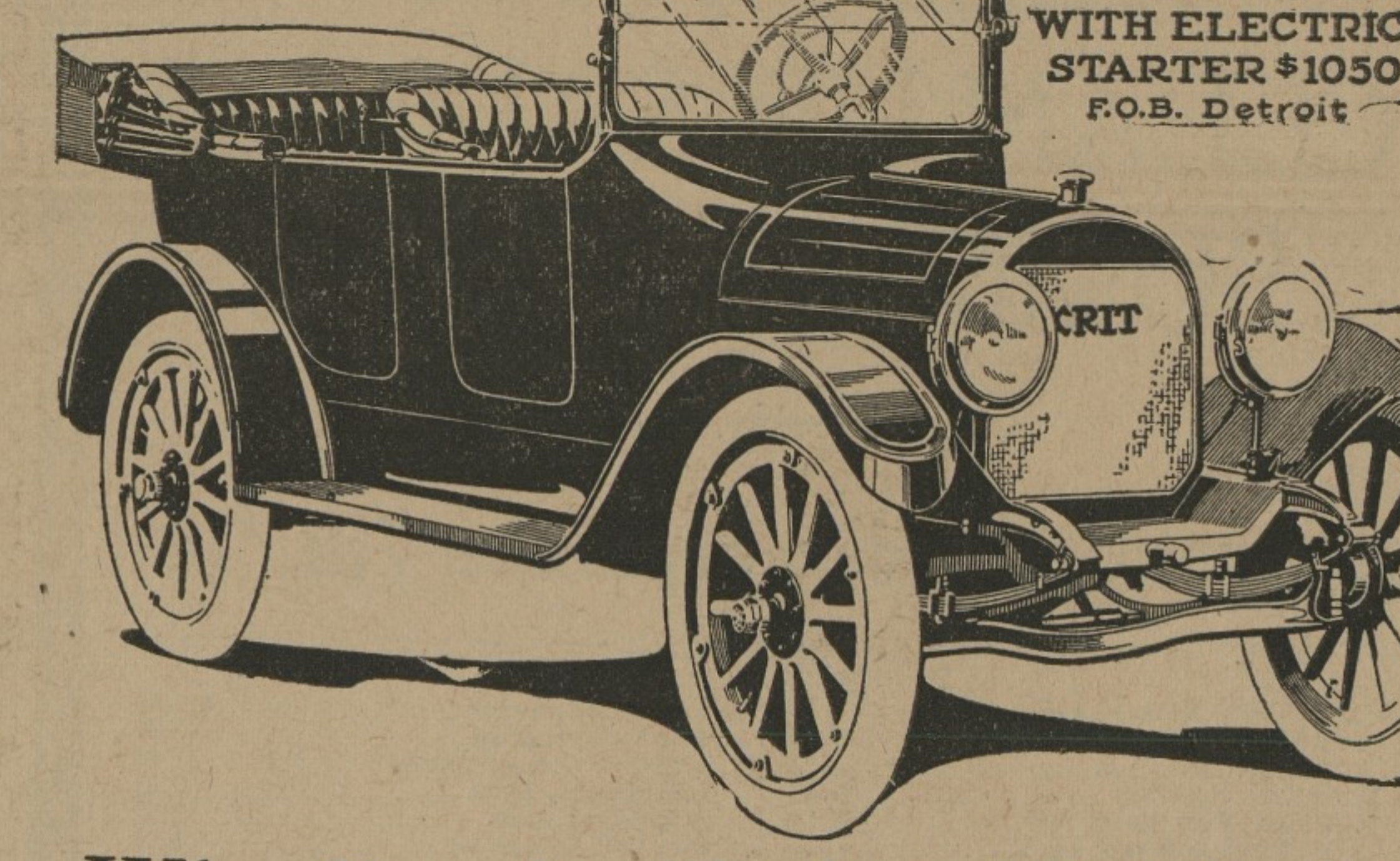
