ACTS 1914, CHAPTER 453  
AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE III OF THE CONSTITUTION, ADDING  
THERE TO A NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 60.

Section 60. The General Assembly of Maryland shall have the power to provide by suitable general enactment (a) for the suspension of sentence by the Court in criminal cases; (b) for any form of the indeterminate sentence in criminal cases; and (c) for the release upon parole in whatever manner the General Assembly may prescribe of convicts imprisoned under sentence for crimes.

AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND BY ADDING

Provides for the submission in certain cases to the voters of the State, for their adoption or rejection of laws passed by the General Assembly. Being the fourth proposed amendment set out in the Governor's Proclamation.
