## WILL TEST STATE ROADS FOR TRACTION ENGINES

State Road Chairman, O. E. Weller, issued a circular letter, this week, to the country press, which we publish in full. The Enterprise is always glad to publish items of interest relative to the state road question, and will publish the result of the traction engine trial, whether favorable or otherwise. Chairman Weller says:

"Next year we expect to complete the State Roads system, consisting of approximately ten hundred and fifty miles, which will connect every county-seat in Maryland with the city of Baltimore. The cost of this system has been large, and the maintenance will be more or less expensive. We feel that we are obligated, and that it should be the duty of every citizen in the State to assist us in enforcing the laws regulating the traffic on State roads, in order to reduce the damage to the minimum.

We have a law, which is being enforced, regulating the speed of automobiles, the weight of automobile trucks, etc., and the load a wagon or automobile truck should carry, which is governed by the width of the tires; also a law stating that no traction engine with cleats on the wheels can be operated on our State roads. We have been unable to enforce this traction engine law, because of the fact that the owners of these machines have made the farmers believe that a traction engine cannot be operated with smooth wheels on State roads.

At a trial several weeks ago, eight or nine traction engine owners testified that it would be impossible to operate a traction engine pulling the ordinary threshing outfit on our State roads, if it were equipped with smooth bands on the driving wheels. A number of farmers testified also in favor of the traction engine owners to the effect that they believed that if the owners were compelled to equip their engines with smooth bands, in accordance with the law, they would be unable to have their wheat threshed. We believe that the farmers were sincere in their testimony, but mistaken as to the facts.

We offered at this trial to equip any of the defendants' engines with smooth bands, and make a demonstration, and should it not prove entirely satisfactory, we would withdraw our case, and would not attempt to enforce the law in the future. Not one of the traction engine owners present offered his machine for the demonstration. We have now arranged with a traction engine owner for the rental of an engine and the necessary threshing machinery, and have equipped the engine with smooth bands. We propose to make a demonstration next week on the road from Cumberland to Frederick, over the Allegany and Blue Ridge Mountains, the most mountainous part of Maryland. The Baltimore daily papers will send representatives, who will report the demonstration. If we succeed in demonstrating that a traction engine with smooth wheels can pull the usual threshing outfit, and that the putting on and taking off of these bands consumes only a reasonable length of time, won't you, as a moulder of public opinion, and for the sake of good roads, lay these facts before your readers?"
